result has been a theater of surprise that is rich in stage action and experimentally invigorating Demastes examines Guare's tools and techniques such as mixing serious with comic creating characters who break into song and dance inserting stand up comedy routines and drawing from the most absurd incongruities of everyday life In doing so Guare has created plays about the best and worst of humanity about lost souls and about delusional ideals *A Reader in Themed and Immersive Spaces* Scott A.
