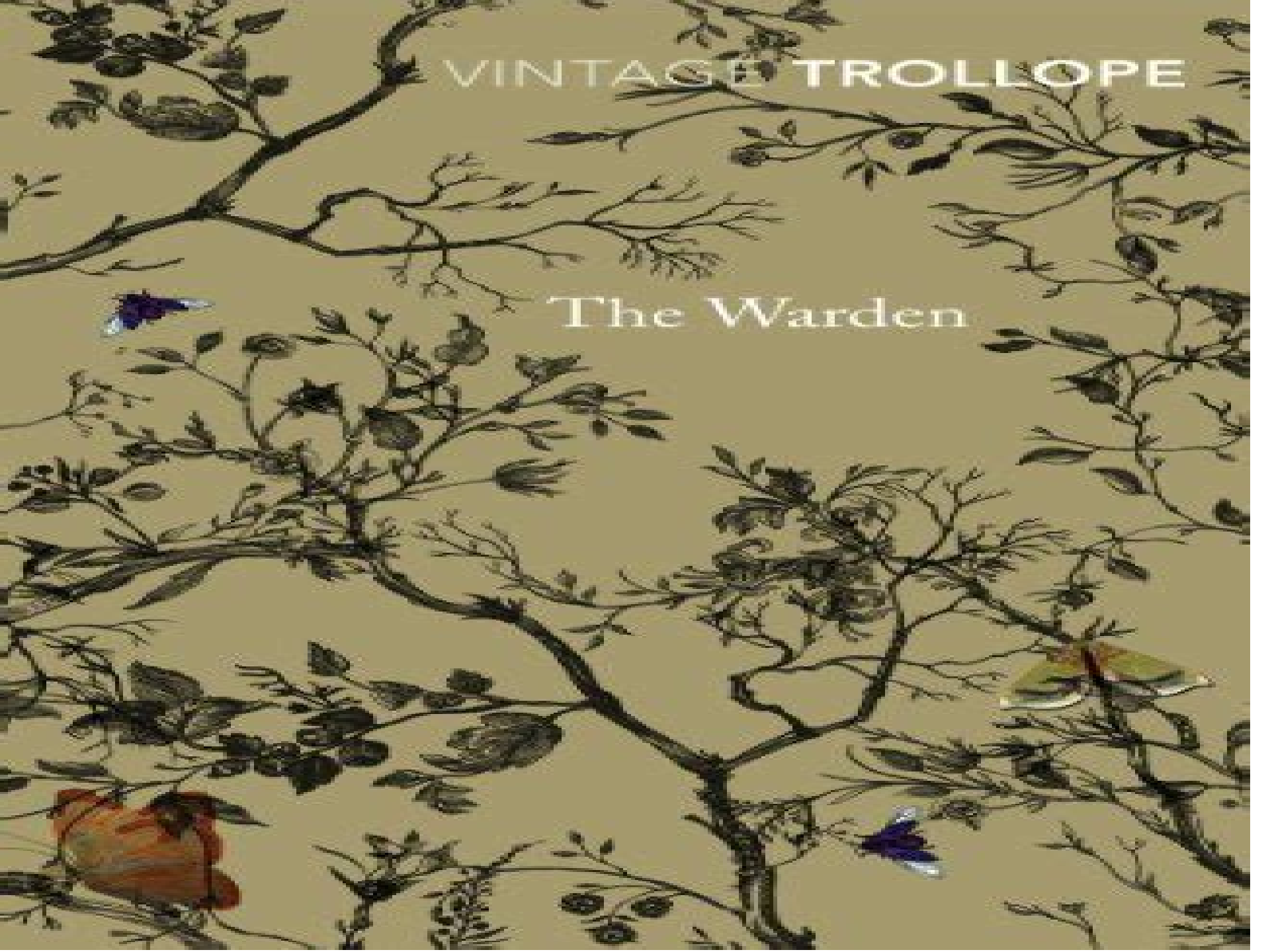

Railway Reading and Late-Victorian Literary Series Paul Raphael Rooney, 2018-05-11 The railway was one of the principal Victorian spaces of reading This book spotlights one of the leading audience demographics in this late Victorian market the newly empowered readers of the expanding middle class The transactions in which late Victorian readers acquired the books read whilst travelling are reconstructed by exploring the leading determinants of consumers purchasing choices at the railway station bookstalls selling books intended for reading in this zone This exploration concentrates on the impact of forces like the input of the staff running the bookstalls and the commercial environment in which consumers made their purchases At the center of this study is a leading and still relatively under examined genre of Victorian print culture circulating in this reading space the series Rooney examines three leading examples of late Victorian series which sought to satisfy railway passengers need for literary reading matter Many of the period s principal authors and literary genres featured in their lists Each venture is representative of one of the three main pricing tiers of series publishing Employing an eclectic methodological framework combining cultural studies and book history approaches with concepts from the new humanities the reading experiences furnished by the light fiction of these series are reconstructed This study reflects the recent growth in scholarship on historical readership the expansion in the canon of Victorian popular literature and the broader material turn in nineteenth century studies

Conspiracy, Revolution, and Terrorism from Victorian Fiction to the Modern Novel Adrian Wisnicki, 2013-01-11 Drawing on critical and theoretical work by Miller Boone Foucault Jameson and others as

well as cultural history affect theory and contemporary psychiatric literature the author defines and explores what he calls the Victorian conspiracy narrative tradition a tradition which embraces classic Victorian works like Bleak House Great Expectations Villette and The Moonstone as well as later Victorian and Edwardian novels by James Conrad and Chesterton and early spy thrillers such as The Riddle of the Sands and The Thirty Nine Steps In reading these works as instances of a single literary tradition the conspiracy narrative tradition the author traces how the representation of conspiracy changes in nineteenth century British literature and argues that many of these changes occur in response to significant Victorian era developments such as the European revolutions of 1848 49 the rise of British law enforcement agencies the growth of Irish Fenian terrorism and the fin de si cle waning of the British Empire The book also explores the roles that conspiratorial indeterminacy and irony play in shaping the Victorian conspiracy narrative tradition and examines how modern works by Proust Kafka and Pynchon appropriate elements from Victorian conspiracy narratives Finally in using recent work on affect theory as well as studies of paranoia by Freud Shapiro and Meissner the book traces how Victorian works fashion the paranoid subject a discursive process that ultimately leads to the emergence of the modern fictional conspiracy theorist

The Warden - The Original Classic Edition Anthony Trollope, 2012-06 Finally available a high quality book of the original classic edition of The Warden This is a new and freshly published edition of this culturally important work by Anthony Trollope which is now at last again available to you Enjoy this classic work today These selected paragraphs distill the contents and give you a quick look inside The Warden In the year 1434 there died at Barchester one John Hiram who had made money in the town as a wool stapler and in his will he left the house in which he died and certain meadows and closes near the town still called Hiram s Butts and Hiram s Patch for the support of twelve superannuated wool carders all of whom should have been born and bred and spent their days in Barchester he also appointed that an alms house should be built for their abode with a fitting residence for a warden which warden was also to receive a certain sum annually out of the rents of the said butts and patches Such was his character in Barchester so universal was his popularity that the very fact of his appointment would have quieted louder whispers than those which had been heard but Mr Harding was an open handed just minded man and feeling that there might be truth in what had been said he had on his instalment declared his intention of adding twopence a day to each mans pittance making a sum of sixty two pounds eleven shillings and fourpence which he was to pay out of his own pocket He has talked not unfrequently and heard very much about the wills of old founders and the incomes arising from their estates during the last year or two he did even at one moment feel a doubt since expelled by his son in laws logic as to whether Lord Guildford was clearly entitled to receive so enormous an income as he does from the revenues of St Cross but that he himself was overpaid with his modest eight hundred pounds he who out of that voluntarily gave up sixty two pounds eleven shillings and fourpence a year to his twelve old neighbours he who for the

money does his precentors work as no precentor has done it before since Barchester Cathedral was built such an idea has never sullied his quiet or disturbed his conscience He is aware that at any rate two of his old men have been heard to say that if everyone had his own they might each have their hundred pounds a year and live like gentlemen instead of a beggarly one shilling and sixpence a day and that they had slender cause to be thankful for a miserable dole of twopence when Mr Harding and Mr Chadwick between them ran away with thousands of pounds which good old John Hiram never intended for the like of them The musician was seated in a garden chair just within the summer house so as to allow the violoncello which he held between his knees to rest upon the dry stone flooring before him stood a rough music desk on which was open a page of that dear sacred book that much laboured and much loved volume of church music which had cost so many guineas and around sat and lay and stood and leaned ten of the twelve old men who dwelt with him beneath old John Hiram's roof
