Quercus velutina

Family: Beech (Fagaceae)

Height: 40-60' (12-18 m)

Tree: medium-sized tree, lower branches are ascending before maturity and horizontal at maturity, upper branches ascending, broad round crown

Leaf: lobed, 4–9" (10–22.5 cm) long, alternately attached, 5–7 lobes, each ending in a pointed tip (bristletipped) and separated by deep U-shaped sinuses, shiny green above, yellowish brown below

Bark: shiny dark gray and smooth texture when young becoming nearly black with deep reddish cracks

Flower: light yellow catkin, 1-3" (2.5-7.5 cm) long, made up of many tiny flowers, N" (3 cm) wide

Fruit: green acorn, turns brown at maturity, %" (2 cm) long, almost as wide as long, thin black vertical lines on hull, cap covers the upper half of nut

Fall Color: orange brown

Origin/Age: native: 175-200 years

Habitat: dry sandy soils, steep slopes, sun

Range: throughout

Stan's Notes: One of approximately 60 oak species in the U.S. Two oak groups, red and white, with the Black Oak a member of the red oak group. Acoms of the red oak group mature in two seasons, while white oak group acoms mature in one season. Has heavy fruit crops only infrequently. Nuts are bitter due to tannic acid (tannin). Bark also contains tannin, which was used in tanning animal skins. New leaves unfurling in spring are crimson before turning silvery, then dark green. Highly susceptible to oak wilt disease.
