core assumptions of many secular humanists postmoderns Roman Catholic traditionalists and Islamists In view of the threat of the War on Terror and in the face of the inadequate response of secularist and post modern intellectuals it is vital that we understand and appreciate the profound paradigm shift that occurred during the sixteenth and seventeenth century that led to the unfolding of modern capitalism Despite a plethora of critics Max Weber s one hundred year old thesis still stands
