War and the Health of Nations Zaryab Iqbal, 2010-02-10 Assessments of the costs of war generally focus on the financial political military and territorial risks associated with involvement in violent conflict Often overlooked are the human costs of war particularly their effects on population well being In *War and the Health of Nations* Zaryab Iqbal explores these human costs by offering the first large scale empirical study of the relationship between armed conflict and population health Working within the influential human security paradigm which emphasizes the security of populations rather than states as the central object of global security Iqbal analyzes the direct and indirect mechanisms through which violent conflict degrades population health In addition to battlefield casualties these include war's detrimental economic effects its role in the creation of refugees and forced migration and the destruction of societies infrastructure In doing so she provides a comprehensive picture of the processes through which war and violent conflict affect public health and the well being of societies in a cross national context *War and the Health of Nations* provides a conceptual and theoretical framework for understanding the influence of violent interstate and intrastate conflict on the quality of life of populations and empirically analyzes the war and health relationship through statistical models using a universal sample of states The analyses provide strong evidence for the direct as well as the indirect effects of war on public health and offer important insights into key socio economic determinants of health achievement The book thus demonstrates the significance of population health as an important consequence of armed conflict and highlights the role of societal vulnerabilities in studies of global security

The International Medical Relief Corps in Wartime China, 1937-1945 Robert Mamlok, M.D., 2018-10-03 Both before and during World War II the Nazis restricted the rights of Jewish and communist doctors Some fought back first by fighting against Fascism in the Spanish Civil War and then by helping the Chinese in their struggle against Japan There were however two rival factions in China One favored Chiang Kai shek the nationalists and the other the communists and 27 foreign medical personnel were caught between them Amidst poverty war and corruption living conditions were poor and traveling was hazardous This book follows members of the Chinese Red Cross Medical Relief Corps through the war as they became enemy aliens and pursued their work despite the perils These doctors had a keen sense of public health needs and contributed to the recognition and management of infectious diseases and nutritional disorders all the while denouncing corruption inhumanity and inequality

War Trauma and its Aftermath Laurence Armand French,Lidija Nikolic-Novakovic,2011-12-16 War trauma has long been associated with post traumatic stress disorder PTSD a term coined in 1980 to explain the post war impact of Vietnam veterans The Gulf and Balkan wars added new dimensions to the traditional PTSD definition due largely to the changing dynamics of these wars With these wars came unprecedented use of reserve and National Guard personnel in U S forces along with the largest contingent of female military personnel to date Rapid deployment sexual assaults and suicides surfaced as paramount untreated problems within coalition force Rapes torture suicides and a high prevalence of untreated civilian victims of the Balkan wars added to the new dimensions of the traumatic stress continuum Suicide bombers and roadside bombings added to the definition of combat stress as military personnel in Iraq and Afghanistan were forced to be constantly vigilant for these attacks regardless of whether they served in combat areas
