Three Lives Gertrude Stein, 2023-06-16 In *Three Lives* are the stories of three working class women from Bridgepoint a town loosely based on Baltimore in the early twentieth century Each story tells of the hopes loves romances and sadnesses of the women as they live their lives Written in a unconventional style the lives of the three women are uncovered through their layered conversations and interactions more than through detailed depictions The book is notable for its descriptions of homosexual romance something that at the time in the USA wasn't accepted indeed Gertrude Stein moved with her partner to Paris to be able to live openly *Three Lives* was Gertrude Stein's first published book and although the sales weren't as expected it was generally well received by critics It's considered today to be among her more accessible books and is a regular on English literature curricula

THREE LIVES (Modern Classics Series) Gertrude Stein, 2016-08-17 This carefully crafted ebook *THREE LIVES Modern Classics Series* is formatted for your eReader with a functional and detailed table of contents *Three Lives* tells the story of three common women living in Bridgepoint a fictional town based on Baltimore The three stories are independent of each other but share much more than a same town The First Story The Good Anna tells the tale of life and death of a housekeeper Anna and her difficulties with unreliable under servants and stray dogs and cats Although her job is hard and often quite dull Anna remains happy with her green parrot that brings colors to her life Melanctha focuses upon the distinctions and blending of race sex gender and female health The main character Melanctha daughter of a black father and mixed race mother in segregated Bridgepoint goes throughout the life on a quest for knowledge and power as she is dissatisfied with her role in the world The Gentle Lena follows the life of Lena a German girl brought to Bridgepoint by a cousin Lena begins her life in America as a servant girl but is eventually married to Herman Kreder the son of German immigrants Both Herman and Lena are marked by extraordinary passivity and the marriage is essentially made in deference to the desires of their elders Gertrude Stein 1874-1946 was an American novelist poet playwright and art collector best known for *Three Lives* *The Making of Americans* and *Tender Buttons* Stein moved to Paris in 1903 and made France her home for the remainder of her life Picasso and Cubism were an important influence on Stein's writing Her works are compared to James Joyce's *Ulysses* and to Marcel Proust's *In Search of Lost Time* **Sherwood**

In *Life in the Writings of Storm Jameson* Elizabeth Maslen reveals a figure who held her own beside fellow British women writers including Virginia Woolf anticipated the Angry Young Women such as Doris Lessing and was an early champion of such European writers as Arthur Koestler and Czesław Miłosz. Jameson was a complex character whose politics were grounded in social justice she was passionately antifascist her novel *In the Second Year* 1936 raised the alarm about Nazism but always wary of communism. An eloquent polemicist Jameson was as president of the British PEN during the 1930s and 1940s of invaluable assistance to refugee writers. Elizabeth Maslen's biography introduces a true twentieth-century hedgehog whose essays and subtly experimental fiction were admired in Europe and the States [The Outside Thing](#) Hannah Roche, 2019-05-28 In a lecture delivered before the University of Oxford's Anglo-French Society in 1936 Gertrude Stein described romance as the outside thing that is always a thing to be felt inside. Hannah Roche takes Stein's definition as a principle for the reinterpretation of three major modernist lesbian writers showing how literary and affective romance played a crucial yet overlooked role in the works of Stein Radclyffe Hall and Djuna Barnes. *The Outside Thing* offers original readings of both canonical and peripheral texts including Stein's first novel *Q.E.D. Things As They Are* Hall's *Adam's Breed* and *The Well of Loneliness* and Barnes's early writing alongside *Nightwood*. Is there an inside space for lesbian writing or must it always seek refuge elsewhere? Crossing established lines of demarcation between the in and the out the real and the romantic and the Victorian and the modernist *The Outside Thing* presents romance as a heterosexual plot upon which lesbian writers willfully set up camp. These writers boldly adopted and adapted the romance genre Roche argues as a means of staking a queer claim on a heteronormative institution. Refusing to submit or surrender to the straight traditions of the romance plot they turned the rules to their advantage. Drawing upon extensive archival research *The Outside Thing* is a significant rethinking of the interconnections between queer writing lesbian living and literary modernism **A Joseph Conrad Companion** Leonard Orr, Theodore Billy, 1999-07-30 Best known as the author of *Heart of Darkness* 1899 Joseph Conrad 1857-1924 is one of the most widely
