The Theme of Promise in the Epistle to the Hebrews Daniel Stevens,2025-04-24 Daniel Stevens analyses the use of the language of divine commitment in the Epistle to the Hebrews arguing that the author distinguishes promise from the cultic language of covenant to sketch a unique mixture of continuity and discontinuity among the people of God across time Stevens stresses through an exegesis of relevant passages that rest is not the primary content of promise nor is it the primary lens through which the other instances of promise language should be understood suggesting instead that the promise is most closely associated with the benefits promised to Abraham and then mediated through the various subsequent covenants He further explores how the divine promise relates to both the Old and New Covenants arguing that Hebrews develops a view of salvation history in which covenants are founded upon promises and then bring those promises to fruition By demonstrating the ways in which this understanding of promise sheds light on the author s hermeneutic and on his method of achieving his hortatory purposes for the epistle Stevens concludes in a reassertion of the consistency of the author s thought regarding promise

Bush,1999-03-01 The New Orleans writer Grace King was an intensely loyal daughter of the South Fostered by bitter memories of the Civil War her loyalty was kept burning by her family s struggle to regain its wealth and maintain its social position during the long agony of Reconstruction In Grace King A Southern Destiny Robert Bush tells of King s life and her art both of which she enthusiastically dedicated to the memory and welfare of her region her city and her family When she began writing in 1886 it was out of a sense of anger at what she saw as George Washington Cable s disloyalty to the South his deliberately false portrayal of New Orleans Creoles and blacks King was herself a conservative in racial matters and a number of her stories celebrate the loyalty that she has observed freed slaves showing their former masters But Grace King was far from conservative in her determination to earn money as a writer and to master the ideas of her era neither endeavor
