life What was it like to wear the uniforms of the period what did you eat what medical treatment was available and how to withstand the lash are also covered **The American Sharpe** Gareth Glover,2016-10-30 Sharpe and his adventures has made the 95th Foot renowned again and the discovery of an unpublished diary by an American from Charleston South Carolina who served despite his father s objections as an officer in this elite regiment has caused great excitement James Penman Gairdner was born in Charleston South Carolina but he was sent back to the Old Country for his education receiving his schooling at Harrow After school rather than joining his father s merchant business he decided to become a soldier receiving a commission in the famous 95th Rifles He subsequently served without a break from the siege of Ciudad Rodrigo in January 1812 until the end of the war in 1814 He then fought in the Waterloo campaign and formed part of the Army of Occupation He was wounded on three occasions Throughout his service he kept a journal which he managed to maintain on almost a daily basis This journal along with a number of letters that he wrote to his family have been edited by renowned historian Gareth Glover and are presented here to the public for the first time Readers will not find dramatic stories of great battles or adventurous escapades Instead Gairdner details the everyday life of one of Wellington s soldiers one of marches and billets of the weather the places and the people of the Iberian Peninsula and of Paris and Occupied France the real nature of soldiering His diaries also highlight the very strange relationship between these newly independent Americans and the Old Country they had so recently fought with which even allowed for a true American boy to fight in the British Army but not in America A Desperate Business Ian Fletcher,2001 A desperate business was how the Duke of Wellington described the Battle of Waterloo following the Allied victory there on 18 June 1815 Here historian Ian Fletcher tells the story of the Waterloo Campaign and illustrates just how desperate the battle was with Wellington s Anglo Dutch army hanging on grimly to the ridge at Mont St Jean until their Prussian allies arrived to put the seal on one of the most decisive victories in military history A Desperate Business differs from many of the books on Waterloo for two reasons first it tells the story not only of the three days battle from 15 to 18 June but of the entire campaign from its beginning in March 1815 right up to the Allie s entrance into Paris three months later Second whilst acknowledging the part played by their Dutch Belgian Hanoverian and Prussian allies it sets out to tell the story from the point of view of Wellington and the British Army only Making extensive use of eye witness accounts the book examines how the British Army a pale shadow of that which had served in the Peninsula fared against the French Army in what was the first and only encounter between the two great commanders of the age Wellington and Napoleon *The Armies of Wellington* Philip J. Wellington was without doubt a brilliant field commander but his leadership style was abrupt and occasionally uncompromising especially to his artillery. He trained his infantry generals as divisional commanders but not army commanders for his cavalry commanders he had little time often pouring scorn on their inability to control their units and formation in battle but it was his artillery commanders that he kept at arm's length in particular suspicious of their different chain of higher command and of their selection through ability rather than privilege. In consequence Wellington's relationship with his gunners was dutiful at best and occasionally failed completely. Frequently frustrated by his lack of control and influence over the artillery off the battlefield Wellington would occasionally over exert his authority on it personally deploying the guns sometimes against the advice of his experts. Wellington's personal distrust culminated in a letter to The Master General of the Ordnance in December 1815 in which he commented to tell you the truth I was not very pleased with the Artillery in the battle of Waterloo. This resulted in the mistaken belief that the gunners performed badly at this crucial battle supposedly abandoning their guns and fleeing the field in direct contrast to French eyewitness accounts. *Wellington's Guns* is the long overdue story of this often stormy relationship, the frustrations, challenges, the characters and the achievements of the main protagonists as well as a detailed account of the British artillery of this period. Even with the valiant contribution of some 12 000 gunner officers, NCOs and rank and file five battery honour titles and numerous primary accounts this is a story which has never been told. This despite

the fact that the artillery itself was revolutionized during the course of the Napoleonic Wars from developing the vital danger close missions in the woods of Hougomont Belgium to the mountain gun attacks during the Pyrenean campaign of the Peninsular War and creeping barrages and Congreve rockets in all theatres with the ultimate result that the artillery itself became a crucial component of any future and indeed modern army **Wellington's Campaigns** C.
