Dale, 1990 159 wise witty and spirited short pieces and essays written for the New Yorker over a span of fifty one years **The American Essay in the American Century** Ned Stuckey-French, 2011-05-31 In modern culture the essay is often considered an old fashioned unoriginal form of literary styling The word essay brings to mind the uninspired five paragraph theme taught in schools around the country or the antiquated Edwardian meanderings of English gentlemen rattling on about art and old books These connotations exist despite the fact that Americans have been reading and enjoying personal essays in popular magazines for decades engaging with a multitude of ideas through this short form means of expression To defend the essay that misunderstood staple of first year composition courses Ned Stuckey French has written *The American Essay in the American Century* This book uncovers the buried history of the American personal essay and reveals how it played a significant role in twentieth century cultural history In the early 1900s writers and critics debated the death of the essay claiming it was too traditional to survive the era s growing commercialism labeling it a bastion of British upper class conventions Yet in that period the essay blossomed into a cultural force as a new group of writers composed essays that responded to the concerns of America s expanding cosmopolitan readership These essays would spark the magazine revolution giving a fresh voice to the ascendant middle class of the young century With extensive research and a cultural context Stuckey French describes the many reasons essays grew in appeal and importance for Americans He also explores the rise of E B White considered by many the greatest American essayist of the first half of the twentieth century whose prowess was overshadowed by his success in other fields of writing White s work introduced a new voice creating an American essay that melded seriousness and political resolve with humor and self deprecation This book is one of the first to consider and reflect on the contributions of E B White to the personal essay tradition and American culture more generally *The American Essay in the American Century* is a compelling highly readable book that illuminates the history of a secretly beloved literary genre A work that will appeal to fiction readers scholars and students alike this book offers fundamental insight into modern American literary history and the intersections of literature culture and class through the personal essay This thoroughly researched volume dismisses once and for all the death of the essay proving that the essay will remain relevant for a very long time to come

understand how nineteenth century Americans answered the question of how the people should participate in politics Did rational public debate the ideal that most democratic theorists now venerate transcend all other forms of political expression How and why did passion disappear from the ideology if not the practice of American democracy To answer these questions she focuses on the political culture of the urban North during the turbulent Jacksonian Age roughly 1830 50 when the shape and character of the democratic public were still fluid Smith s method is to interpret in light of such popular discourse as newspapers and novels several key texts in nineteenth century American political thought Frederick Douglass s Fourth of July speech and Narrative Angelina Grimke s debate with Catharine Beecher Frances Wright s lectures and Harriet Beecher Stowe s Uncle Tom s Cabin Such texts Smith finds highlight many of the then current ideas about the extremes of political expression Her readings support the conclusions that the value of rational argument itself was contested that the emergent Enlightenment rationalism may have helped to sterilize political debate and that storytelling or testimony posed an important challenge to the norm of political rationality Smith explores facets of the political culture in ways that make sense of traditions from Whiggish resistance to Protestant narrative testimony She helps us to understand such puzzles as the point of mob action and other ritualistic disruptions of the political process our simultaneous attraction to and suspicion of political debates and the appeal of stories by and about victims of injustice Also found in her book are keen analyses of the antebellum press and the importance of oratory and public speaking Smith shows that alternatives to reasoned deliberation like protest resistance and storytelling have a place in politics Such alternatives underscore the positive role that interest passion compassion and even violence might play in the political life of America Her book therefore is a cautionary analysis of how rationality came to dominate our thinking about politics and why its hegemony should concern us Ultimately Smith reminds the reader that democracy and reasoned public debate are not synonymous and that the linkage is not necessarily a good thing

Transatlantic Radicals and the Early American Republic Michael Durey,1997 In the transatlantic world of the late eighteenth century easterly winds blew radical thought to America Thomas Paine had already arrived on these shores in 1774 and made his mark as a radical pamphleteer during the Revolution In his wake followed more than 200 other radical exiles English Dissenters Whigs and Painites Scottish lads o parts and Irish patriots who became influential newspaper writers and editors and helped change the nature of political discourse in a young nation Michael Durey has written the first full scale analysis of

these radicals evaluating the long term influence their ideas have had on American political thought Transatlantic Radicals uncovers the roots of their radicalism in the Old World and tells the story of how these men came to be exiled how they emigrated and how they participated in the politics of their adopted country Nearly all of these radicals looked to Paine as their spiritual leader and to Thomas Jefferson as their political champion They held egalitarian anti federalist values and promoted an extreme form of participatory democracy that found a niche in the radical wing of Jefferson s Republican Party Their divided views on slavery however reveal that democratic republicanism was unable to cope with the realities of that institution As political activists during the 1790s they proved crucial to Jefferson s 1800 presidential victory then after his views moderated and their influence waned many repatriated others drifted into anonymity and a few managed to find success in the New World Although many of these men are known to us through other histories their influence as a group has never before been so closely examined Durey persuasively demonstrates that the intellectual ferment in Britain did indeed have tremendous influence on American politics His account of that influence sheds considerable light on transatlantic political history and differences in religious political and economic freedoms Skillfully balancing a large cast of characters Transatlantic Radicals depicts the diversity of their experiences and shows how crucial these reluctant migr s were to shaping our republic in its formative years

Quacks and Crusaders Eric S. Juhnke, 2002 One promoted goat gland transplants as a remedy for lost virility or infertility Another blamed aluminum cooking utensils for causing cancer The third was targeted by the Food and Drug Administration as public enemy number one for his worthless cures John Brinkley Norman Baker and Harry Hoxsey were the ultimate snake oil salesmen of the twentieth century With backgrounds in lowbrow performance carnivals vaudeville night clubs each of these charismatic con men used the emerging power of radio to hawk alternative cures in the Midwest beginning in the roaring twenties through the Depression era and into the 1950s All scorned the medical establishment for avarice while amassing considerable fortunes of their own and although the American Medical Association castigated them for preying on the ignorant this book shows that the case against them wasn t all that simple Quacks and Crusaders is an entertaining and revealing look at the connections between fraudulent medicine and populist rhetoric in middle America Eric Juhnke examines the careers of these three personalities to paint a vision of medicine that championed average Americans denounced elitism and affirmed rustic values All appealed to the common man winning audiences and patrons in rural America by casting their pitches in everyday language and their messages proved more potent than their medicines in treating the fears insecurities and failing health of their numerous supporters Juhnke first examines the career of each man revealing their geniuses as businessmen and propagandists with such success that Brinkley and Baker ran for governor of their states and Hoxsey had thousands of supporters protest his persecution by the FDA Juhnke then investigates the identity motives and willingness to believe of their many patients and followers He shows how all three men used populist rhetoric evangelical anti Communist anti intellectual to attract their clients and then how

their particular brand of populism sometimes mutated to anti-Semitism and other sentiments of the radical right. By treating the incurable Brinkley Baker and Hoxsey took on the mantles of common folk crusaders. Brinkley was idolized for his goat gland cures until his death and Hoxsey's former head nurse continued his work from Tijuana until her death in 1999. In considering who visits quacks and why Juhnke has shed new light not only on the ongoing battle between alternative and organized medicine but also on the persistence of quackery and gullibility in American culture.

Total Cold War Kenneth Alan Osgood, 2006. Osgood focuses on major campaigns such as Atoms for Peace, People to People, and cultural exchange programs.
