

Togi

A large antelope with a prominent 'dorsal' hump, being higher in the hindquarters than in the front. The head is short and globose, dark chocolate-brown with blackish-tan patches extending from the lower cheeks down to the flanks to just above the knees and from the snout down the back legs terminating just above the hoofs. The nose follows this to just beneath the base of the long narrow hairless horn. The horn is the tip of the snout and on the back of the nose. The horns, strictly speaking, appear in both sexes but are larger in the male. They are broadly tapered and reach five months, slightly outwards and upwards towards the tips. The hair is of medium length terminating with tufts of long black hair.

All antelope species graze and some of light coloured birds and white, where they feed almost entirely on grasses and herbages. They are found in small groups of around 12 animals, usually consisting of a dominant bull along with a harem of females and young. They live, however, in groups in forested lowlands during the dry season when grazing is scarce. They will usually migrate with herds of elephants, following other plains ungulates. Although they will drink regularly where water is available, they can also go without water for months without harm. They are active both by day and by night. As they stand you often find standing in a hunched forward, up raised piece of elevated ground, on the back of the pelvis, while other members of the herd remain to graze.

Coke's Hartbeest

A large antelope characterized by its sloping appearance being higher in the hindquarters than in the front. The head is of medium, yellow-brown, lighter on the hindquarters with an almost white snout and underparts. The head and face of the antelope with large pointed ears. The horns are slender, slightly curved towards the back and are deeply ridged and are present in both sexes. The tail is of medium length terminating in a broad white tuft. The female is smaller in the male but usually pale in colour and with smaller, slender horns.

One of the most common of Africa's antelopes, inhabiting open slopes, grassland and dry savannah, sometimes with light wooded areas. They can be found in large groups in savannah but not a few to many thousands. The large concentrations occurring during the dry season when available grazing is limited. They are also seen in solitary and young males and females are the better half. They are active mainly in the early morning and late afternoon, sometimes during the day. They feed mainly on grasses and herbs but will also eat other vegetation where it is available. However, they will also eat other plants and other species of plains ungulates. They are found in a hunched forward posture but they can sometimes be seen standing on their hind legs. They often migrate with other species of plains ungulates.
