Japan in 1922 Dr Chitose began teaching karate in Kumamoto Japan He refined the Okinawan techniques based on his medical knowledge and officially founded his own style of karate in 1946 in 1952 naming it Chito ryu meaning 1 000 year old style In the late fifties Dr Chitose's top ranking student and protege was Mamoru Yamamoto Yamamoto Mamoru After establishing his own training dojo Yamamoto adapted new fighting techniques and traditional weapons from Okinawa into Chito Ryu After leaving the Chito Kai Federation in 1971 Yamamoto
