through studies of popular risings in Shakespeare Carlyle and the French Revolution the Rebecca Riots in Wales popular ballads and the Indian War of Independence in 1857 post partition riots in India and Pakistan in the 1960s township violence in South African fiction post 1948 the 1965 Watts riots in Los Angeles in detective fiction and avant garde disturbances in France of the 1920s and 1930s Throughout the book these essays focus attention on the tension filled relationship that is perceived between literature and discourses of power and popular resistance

Ethnicity and Cultural Authority Daniel G. Williams, 2005-12-08 Longlisted for the Wales Book of the Year 2007 Writing in 1903 W E B Du Bois suggested that the goal for the African American was to be a co worker in the kingdom of culture He was evoking culture as a solution to the divisions within society thereby adopting in a very different context an idea that had been influentially expressed by Matthew Arnold in the 1860s Du Bois questioned the assumed universality of this concept by asking who ultimately is allowed into the kingdom of culture How does one come to speak from a position of cultural authority This book adopts a transatlantic approach to explore these questions It centres on four Victorian men of letters Matthew Arnold William Dean Howells W B Yeats and W E B Du Bois who drew on notions of ethnicity as a basis from which to assert their cultural authority In comparative close readings of these figures Daniel Williams addresses several key areas of contemporary literary and cultural debate The book questions the notion of the West as it appears and re appears in the formulations of postcolonial theory challenges the widespread tendency to divide nationalism into civic and ethnic forms and forces its readers to reconsider what they mean when they talk about culture identity and national literature

production while he tells the stories of the rich social and cultural lives of periodicals. Paying special attention to the salient characteristics of the Review, The Miscellany and The Little Magazine, Ballin illustrates their histories in comprehensive examples drawn from Ireland and England. In addition to dealing with theorists in the field such as Frantz Fanon, Gayatri Spivak and Homi Bhabha, the book also looks at the construction of Wales as a colonized nation in 20th century literature. A wide range of subject matter is covered including the work of Welsh missionaries in India, the policy of afforestation in Wales before and after World War II, the history of the campaigns for women's rights in Wales and the post-Darwinian racial theories of the 19th century. Some of the authors considered include R. S. Thomas, Emyr Humphreys, Peter Finch and Gwyneth Lewis.
