Why Kierkegaard Matters Marc Alan Jolley, 2010 Monographs on philosophers multiply daily but on occasion the question of why a particular philosopher matters. If we stop thinking about them by asking why then will they cease to exist. When Mercer University Press opened its doors more than thirty years ago it committed itself to religious studies in general and to several thinkers. One of those was Søren Kierkegaard. Now as the Press concludes a major publishing event with the completion of the International Kierkegaard Commentary it seeks to honor the only series editor it has known Robert Perkins. The method of this honor is by asking Why Kierkegaard Matters. The leading Kierkegaard scholars have contributed essays that range from the very personal and memoir-esque to the academic and analytical. As a result this festschrift is not only a book to honor an extraordinary editor but is in its own right a major contribution to the assessment of the importance of Kierkegaard. Written with the general reader in mind this collection will prove useful by both scholar and student and will lead the general reader to encounter one of the most original Christian philosophers in the history of the world. **How to**

Misunderstand Kierkegaard Stuart Dalton, 2022-09-27 This book is an attempt to write about Kierkegaard's philosophy in the style of Kierkegaard's philosophy: energetic, playful, free, spirited, surprising, and joyous. It is a deliberately crumbly book in the sense that it seeks out the fragments, scraps, and crumbs of philosophical arguments that are generally ignored or swept away like so much rubbish but that are actually the most interesting parts of the meal. The Anti-Assistant Professor Method that this book follows adopts Kierkegaard's many excellent jokes about assistant professors as a guide to how not to write about Kierkegaard's philosophy specifically: Don't cease to be human. Don't be a parasite merely feeding off other people's creations and never creating anything new. Don't reduce or simplify or systematize Kierkegaard's ideas in order to make life easier for everyone because that was never the point. Don't kill Kierkegaard's philosophy by lecturing on it thereby turning it into a collection of dead ideas for nonhumans rather than subjective truths that need to be lived. Following these guidelines the book attempts to extend and amplify some of Kierkegaard's most important ideas in a way that combats the persistent problem of nihilism, a disease that even Kierkegaard succumbed to at the end of his life. **Volume 17: Kierkegaard's**

Pseudonyms Katalin Nun, Jon Stewart, 2016-12-05 One of the elements that many readers admire in Kierkegaard's skill as a writer is his ability to create different voices and perspectives in his works. Instead of unilaterally presenting clear-cut doctrines and theses he confronts the reader with a range of personalities and figures who all espouse different views. One important aspect of this play of perspectives is Kierkegaard's controversial use of pseudonyms. The present volume is dedicated to exploring the different pseudonyms and authorial voices in Kierkegaard's writing. The articles featured here try to explore each pseudonymous author as a literary figure and to explain what kind of a person is at issue in each of the pseudonymous works. Marshall, 2013-08-30 Most of what is written on Kierkegaard today is for the college classroom and academic conferences The guiding question of this book is that if Kierkegaard's words about Christianity are true how do they change the way we learn and practice the Christian faith today

This book is an answer to that question It does not enter into an extended critical discussion over the truth of Kierkegaard s ideas Instead it just believes what Kierkegaard said and runs with it It does that by showing how his ideas change our understanding of Christian identity suffering and illness worship and preaching the Bible baptism prayer marriage and divorce criticism and the Christian minister Interspersed are many quotations from Martin Luther whose thought significantly shaped Kierkegaard s At the end of the book is a hefty collection of sermons to show how all of this can be preached in the church What Kierkegaard for the Church adds to our understanding of Kierkegaard is the place of the church in his thought Because of his criticisms of the Danish state church and his stress on the need for the single individual to appropriate Christian teachings it could be imagined that he rejected the church But that would be to throw the baby out with the bath The fact is that Kierkegaard remained a loyal son of the church even while he attacked it And he did this only so he could strengthen what he loved
