Mills, 2012-10-26 This volume brings together aspects of contemporary study of cultural geography and selected passages from prophetic texts of the Hebrew Bible Old Testament The aim is to identify how the image of the city helps to construct meaning inside the biblical material In order to carry out this task relevant textual narratives are analysed and then read from the viewpoint of space place and urban studies This latter category includes the works of Lefebvre Bachelard Soja Massey Amin and Thrift and Pile among others A major finding is that urban imagination is a tool by which the texts manage the experience of political and social events in a time of radical change

Space, Land, Territory, and the Study of the Bible Stephen C. Russell, 2017-03-06 In this brief volume written for professional biblical scholars and graduate students being trained in Bible Stephen C Russell introduces the reader to the interdisciplinary study of space and its related concepts including land territory border frontier nature scale spatial flows and rhythm He offers a synopsis of eight approaches to the study of space that have been influential in the humanities and social sciences in recent decades sacred legal political economic ecological visual social and urban approaches He pays special attention to Henri Lefebvre's treatment of social space as a social product The volume also briefly notes some of the work being done by biblical scholars in conversation with spatial studies

Deluty, 2024-04-02 In *Prophet Intermediary King The Dynamics of Mediation in the Biblical World and Old Babylonian Mari* Julie B Deluty investigates the mediation of prophecy for kings in biblical narratives and the Old Babylonian corpus from Mari In many cases the prophet's message is delivered through a third party sometimes a royal official or family member who may exercise a degree of autonomy in the transmission of the words Drawing on social network theory the book highlights the importance of third party intermediaries in the process of communication that lies at the core of biblical and ancient Near Eastern prophecy Recognition of the place of non prophetic intermediaries in a monarchic system offers a new dimension to
