- Types
 - Symptomatic
 - Usually R/T colorectal disease/may have blood or mucus Overflow
 - Caused by constipation, where the feces fills the entire colon
 - Patient passes semi-formed stool frequently
 - Can be seen in patients with long term laxative use
 - Treat by cleansing over 7-10 days, then work on constipation
 - Neurogenic
 - Patients who do not voluntarily delay defecation
 - Usually with dementia
 - Anorectal
 - Nerve damage which weakens muscles in the pelvic floor
 - Have several incontinent stools per day
