border zone In the late 1990s as white South Africans began to establish timber plantations in Mozambique that difference began to be effaced Under the banner of environmentalism and economic progress tourism firms were allowed to claim peasant farmland The objectives of liberal conservationists and developers though high minded led them to commoditize ancestral lands Southern African policymakers supported this new form of colonization as a form of racial integration between white investors and black peasants paving the way for an ironic and contentious situation in which ethnic tolerance gentrification and land grabbing have gone hand in hand From Enslavement to Environmentalism engages topics central to current debates in anthropology resource politics and development policy and will be of interest to both regional specialists and generalists
