Industrial Relations After Pinochet Indira Palacios-Valladares, 2011 In recent decades many countries have implemented neoliberal reforms that have had adverse consequences for unions In Chile this process was particularly sweeping having occurred under the right wing dictatorship of General Augusto Pinochet Despite the transition to democracy in 1990 the labor relations system created by the Pinochet regime is still largely in place Although a number of works have assessed the conditions of unionism in post dictatorship Chile little attention has been paid to the firm level which is where most of the collective bargaining now takes place This book takes a qualitative approach to examining the dynamics of collective bargaining at the firm level in democratic Chile by investigating the causes of variation in the bargaining outcomes of fifty three unions in four firms in the banking manufacturing retail and telecommunications sectors It seeks to explain both variation in individual union bargaining outcomes within firms and aggregate differences in outcomes between firms The book also provides a systematic explanation of the decline of collective bargaining results among Chilean unions in general during the 1990s and early 2000s

Labor in Israel Jonathan Preminger, 2018-04-15 Using a comprehensive analysis of the wave of organizing that swept the country starting in 2007 *Labor in Israel* investigates the changing political status of organized labor in the context of changes to Israel's political economy including liberalization the rise of non union labor organizations the influx of migrant labor and Israel's complex relations with the Palestinians Through his discussion of organized labor's relationship to the political community and its nationalist political role Preminger demonstrates that organized labor has lost the powerful status it

enjoyed for much of Israel's history. Despite the weakening of trade unions and the Histadrut, however, he shows the ways in which the fragmentation of labor representation has created opportunities for those previously excluded from the labor movement regime. Organized labor is now trying to renegotiate its place in contemporary Israel, a society that no longer accepts labor's longstanding claim to be the representative of the people. As such, Preminger concludes that organized labor in Israel is in a transitional and unsettled phase in which new marginal initiatives, new organizations, and new alliances that have blurred the boundaries of the sphere of labor have not yet consolidated into clear structures of representation or accepted patterns of political interaction.

Challenges for the Democratisation Process in Tanzania Jonas Ewald,2013-07-24 Tanzania has been independent in 2011 for 50 years While most neighbouring states have gone through violent conflicts Tanzania has managed to implement extensive reforms without armed political conflicts Hence Tanzania is an interesting case for Peace and Development research This dissertation analyses the political development in Tanzania since the introduction of the multiparty system in 1992 with a focus on the challenges for the democratisation process in connection with the 2000 and 2005 elections The question of to what extent Tanzania had moved towards a consolidation of democracy

is analysed by looking at nine different institutions of importance for democratisation grouped in four spheres the state the political civil and economic society Focus is on the development of the political society and the role of the opposition in particular The analysis is based on secondary and primary material collected between September 2000 to April 2010 The main conclusion is that even if the institutions of liberal democracy have gradually developed in practice single party rule has continued manifested in the 2005 election when the CCM won 92% of seats Despite impressive economic growth poverty remains deep and has not been substantially reduced On a theoretical level this brings the old debate between liberal and substantive democracy back to the fore Neither the economic nor the political reforms have brought about a transformation of the political and economic system resulting in the poor majority gaining substantially more political influence and improved economic conditions Hence it is argued that the interface between the economic political and administrative reforms has not been sufficiently considered in the liberal democratic tradition Liberal democracy is necessary for a democratic development but not sufficient for democracy to be consolidated For that a substantive democratic development is necessary
