In the modern Greek city of Thessaloniki the ruins of a vast Jewish cemetery lie buried under the city's university Nearby is the site of the childhood home of one of the founders of the modern Turkish state These are tantalizing reminders of what was once the bustling cosmopolitan city of Salonica home not just to Greeks but to thousands of Sephardic Jews Turks Bulgarians and Armenians living and working peacefully alongside one another Thessaloniki is just one example among many of what used to be Over the past two centuries ethnic cleansing has remade the map of Central and Eastern Europe and the Middle East transforming vast empires that embraced many ethnic groups into nearly homogenous nations Towns and cities from Germany to Turkey still show traces of the vanished and nearly forgotten ethnic and religious communities that once called these places home In Terrible Fate Benjamin Lieberman describes the violent transformations that occurred in Salonica and hundreds of other towns and cities as the Ottoman Russian Austro-Hungarian and German empires collapsed to be reborn as the modern nation states we know today
