Uber Psychoanalyse: Funf Vorlesungen *Sigmund Freud, 2018-09-02 *ber Psychoanalyse F nf Vorlesungen* by Sigmund Freud **Five Lectures On Psychoanalysis** Sigmund Freud, 1977 Includes index bibliography *Freud's Theory and Its Use in Literary and Cultural Studies* Henk de Berg, 2004 Rarely has a single figure had as much influence on Western thought as Sigmund Freud His ideas permeate our culture to such a degree that an understanding of them is indispensable Yet many otherwise well informed students in the humanities labor under misconceptions or lack of knowledge about Freudian theory There are countless introductions to Freudian psychoanalysis but surprisingly none that combine a genuinely accessible account of Freud s ideas with an introduction to their use in literary and cultural studies as this book does It is written specifically for use by advanced undergraduate and graduate students in courses dealing with literary and cultural criticism yet will also be of interest to the general reader The book consists of two parts Part one explains Freud s key ideas focusing on the role his theories of repression conscious and unconscious mental processes sexuality dreams free associations Freudian slips resistance and transference play in psychoanalysis and on the relationship between ego superego and id Here de Berg refutes many popular misconceptions using examples throughout The assumption underlying this account is that Freud offers not simply a model of the mind but an analysis of the relation between the individual and society Part two discusses the implications of Freudian psychoanalysis for the study of literature and culture Among the topics analyzed are Hamlet Heinrich Heine s Lore Ley Freud s Totem and Taboo and its influence on literature the German student movement of the late 1960s and the case of the Belgian pedophile Marc Dutroux and the public reactions to it Existing books focus either on Freudian psychoanalysis in general or on psychoanalytic literary or cultural criticism those in the latter category tend to be abstract and theoretical in nature None of them are suitable for readers who are interested in psychoanalysis as a tool for literary and cultural criticism but have no firm knowledge of Freud s ideas **Sigmund Freud House Bulletin**, 1975

Freud's Schreber Between Psychiatry and Psychoanalysis Thomas Dalzell, 2018-03-29 This book investigates what was distinctive about the predisposition to psychosis Freud posited in Daniel Paul Schreber a presiding judge in Saxony's highest court It argues that Freud's 1911 Schreber text reversed the order of priority in late nineteenth century conceptions of the disposing causes of psychosis the objective biological and subjective biographical to privilege subjective disposition to psychosis but without returning to the paradigms of early nineteenth century Romantic psychiatry and without obviating the legitimate claims of biological psychiatry in relation to hereditary disposition While Schreber is the book's reference point this is not a general treatment of Schreber or of Freud's reading of the Schreber case It focuses rather on what was new in Freud's thinking on the disposition to psychosis what he learned from his psychiatrist contemporaries and what he did not and whether or not psychoanalysts have fully received his aetiology

broadly and offers a discussion of the Celebrity Worship Syndrome Chapter Three provides a very brief history of the concept of celebrity itself arguing that contrary to popular opinion the culture of celebrification cannot be blamed on twenty first century media moguls but rather that such a preoccupation with famous personalities can be traced back to ancient times and demonstrates the need to broaden our analysis to include the role of deep unconscious psychological forces In Chapter Four Kahr reviews some important theoretical concepts advanced by Freud and Winnicott which provide an important foundation for the psychoanalytic study of fame while Chapter Five provides a more comprehensive theory of the unconscious psychological roots of the need to worship fame and to seek it drawing upon a multitude of sources ranging from psychoanalytic theory and developmental psychological research to film archaeology and perhaps surprisingly the history of infanticide The book concludes in Chapter Six by studying the psychodynamics of celebrity and fame arguing that being recognised by one's family and friends in the intimate context of home life may well be the very best way to become a celebrity Celebrity Mad outlines a psychoanalytic theory of the roots of our obsession with fame It will be of great interest to psychoanalytic practitioners and researchers as well as to readers interested in the psychology of fame
