Therese Raquin Play:

Thérèse Raquin Neal Bell, 1998 *Thérèse Raquin*, 2006 A gripping psychological thriller adapted for the stage by Emile Zola himself from his own notorious novel in a version by Nicholas Wright Stifled by an oppressive mother in law and a sickly husband Thérèse Raquin falls passionately for another man Their feverish affair drives the lovers to an act of terrible desperation which catapults them headlong into a world more claustrophobic than the one they sought to destroy This English version of Thérèse Raquin was first staged at the National Theatre London in 2006 Therese Raquin Emile Zola, 2005-02-22 Zola's classic novel of turbulent passion now appearing on Broadway at the Roundabout Theatre starring Keira Knightley In a dingy apartment on the Passage du Pont Neuf in Paris Thérèse Raquin is trapped in a loveless marriage to her sickly cousin Camille The numbing tedium of her life is suddenly shattered when she embarks on a turbulent affair with her husband's earthy friend Laurent but their animal passion for each other soon compels the lovers to commit a crime that will haunt them forever Thérèse Raquin caused a scandal when it appeared in 1867 and brought its twenty seven year old author a notoriety that followed him throughout his life Zola's novel is not only an uninhibited portrayal of adultery madness and ghostly revenge but also a devastating exploration of the darkest aspects of human existence Robin Buss's translation superbly conveys Zola's fearlessly honest and matter of fact style combining fidelity to Zola's idiosyncrasies with easy fluency in English This edition also includes an introduction discusses Zola's life and literary career and the influence of art literature and science on his writing as well as the preface to the author's second edition of 1868 a chronology suggestions for further reading and notes For more than seventy years Penguin has been the leading publisher of classic literature in the English speaking world With more than 1 700 titles Penguin Classics represents a global bookshelf of the best works throughout history and across genres and disciplines Readers trust the series to provide authoritative texts enhanced by introductions and notes by distinguished scholars and contemporary authors as well as up to date translations by award winning translators The Making of Theatre History Paul Kuritz, 1988 Thérèse Raquin Emile Zola, 2013-03 Based on Zola's 1867 novel and dramatized by the author in 1873 this play is almost a French version of the Russian novel Crime and Punishment Therese and her lover Laurent decide to kill her likable but sickly husband Camille also her husband and succeed in doing so without arousing any suspicion The boating accident that ends Camille's life also makes Laurent a hero for rescuing Therese The lovers remain apart for a year until friends of the family suggest they marry But both are remorseful and guilt ridden Finally Therese's mother discovers the truth but suffers a stroke and cannot speak She just stares at them and her presence drives the lovers down the path to destruction A powerful and believable story that plays well even today

Thérèse Raquin Emile Zola, 2019-11-02 Thérèse Raquin is a novel by Emile Zola first published in 1867 It was originally published in serial format in the journal *L'Artiste* It was published in book format in December of the same year In 1873 Zola turned Thérèse Raquin into a play Thérèse Raquin tells the story of a young woman unhappily married to her first cousin by a well intentioned and overbearing aunt Her cousin Camille is sickly and selfish and when the opportunity arises Thérèse enters into a tragic affair with one of Camille's friends Laurent
