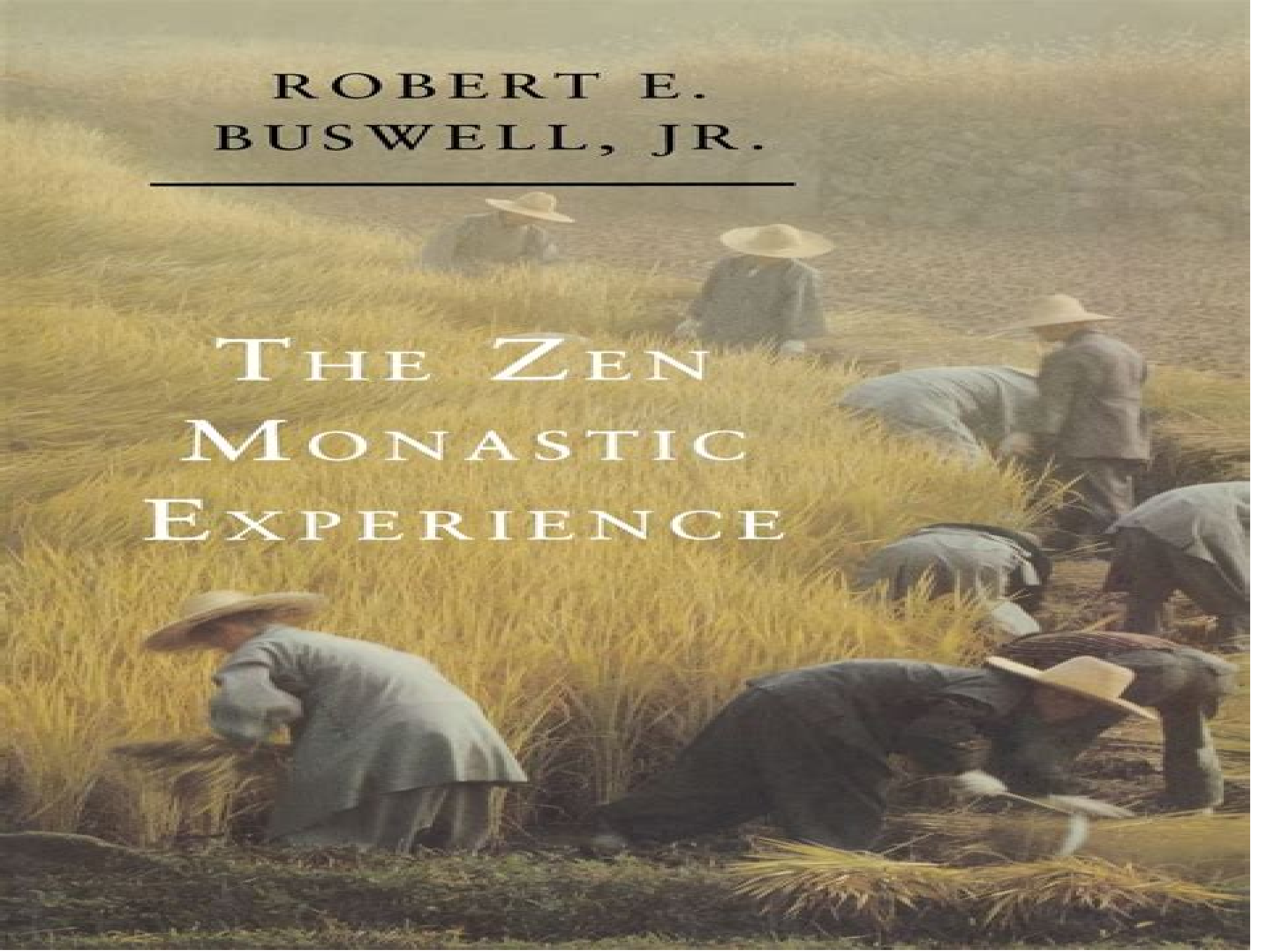

The Zen Monastic Experience Robert E. Buswell, Jr., Robert E. Buswell, 1992 Robert Buswell a Buddhist scholar who spent five years as a Zen monk in Korea draws on personal experience in this insightful account of day to day Zen monastic practice Buswell's depiction of Zen reveals a religious tradition that differs radically from the stereotype prevalent in the West Westerners exposed to Zen through English language materials have been offered a picture of an iconoclastic religion that is bibliophobic institutionally subversive aesthetically sophisticated devoted to manual labor and intent solely on sudden enlightenment Its most revered teachers are depicted as torching their sacred religious icons bullying their students into enlightenment rejecting the value of all the scriptures of Buddhism and even denying the worth of Zen itself In discussing the activities of the postulants the meditation monks the teachers and administrators and the support monks of Song gwang sa a major Korean Buddhist monastery Buswell challenges much of this picture In the counterparadigm of Zen offered in the daily lives of the monks Zen's putative iconoclasts are replaced by resolute members of a community dedicated to a methodical regimen of spiritual training Zen's apparent bibliophobia pales to reveal contemplatives learned in classical Chinese and often having extensive experience in Buddhist seminaries And the brash challenge allegedly made to systematizations of religion even to Zen itself fades before monks with strong faith in the arduous way of life they have undertaken The author's treatment lucidly relates contemporary Zen practice to the historical development of the tradition and to Korean history more generally and his intimate sympathetic portrayal of the life of modern Zen monks in Korea provides an innovative and provocative look at Zen from the inside The Zen Canon Steven Heine, Dale S. Wright, 2008 When books about Zen Buddhism began appearing in Western languages just over a half century ago there was no interest whatsoever in the role of ritual in Zen Indeed what attracted Western readers interest was the Zen rejection of ritual The famous Beat Zen writers were delighted by the Zen emphasis on spontaneity as opposed to planned repetitious action and wrote inspirationally about the demythologized anti ritualized spirit of Zen Quotes from the great Zen masters

supported this understanding of Zen and led to the fervor that fueled the opening of Zen centers throughout the West. Once Western practitioners in these centers began to practice Zen seriously, however, they discovered that zazen Zen meditation is a ritualized practice supported by centuries-old ritual practices of East Asia. Although initially in tension with the popular anti-ritual image of ancient Zen masters, interest in Zen ritual has increased along with awareness of its fundamental role in the spirit of Zen. Eventually Zen practitioners would form the idea of no-mind or the open and awakened state of mind in which ingrained habits of thinking give way to more receptive, direct forms of experience. This notion provides a perspective from which ritual could gain enormous respect as a vehicle to spiritual awakening, and thus this volume seeks to emphasize the significance of ritual in Zen practice. Containing 9 articles by prominent scholars about a variety of topics including Zen rituals, *kinhin* and *zazen*, this volume covers rituals from the early Chan period to modern Japan. Each chapter covers key developments that occurred in the Linji, Rinzai, and Caodong/Soto schools of China and Japan, describing how Zen rituals mold the lives and characters of its practitioners, shaping them in accordance with the ideal of Zen awakening. Ordinary Mind as the Way Mario Poceski, 2007-04-13 Under the leadership of Mazu Daoyi 709-788 and his numerous disciples the Hongzhou School emerged as the dominant tradition of Chan Zen Buddhism in China during the middle part of the Tang dynasty 618-907 Mario Poceski offers a systematic examination of the Hongzhou School's momentous growth and rise to preeminence as the bearer of Chan orthodoxy and analyzes its doctrines against the backdrop of the intellectual and religious milieus of Tang China Poceski demonstrates that the Hongzhou School represented the first emergence of an empire-wide Chan tradition that had strongholds throughout China and replaced the various fragmented Schools of early Chan with an inclusive orthodoxy Poceski's study is based on the earliest strata of permanent sources rather than on the later apocryphal encounter dialogue stories regularly used to construe widely accepted but historically unwarranted interpretations about the nature of Chan in the Tang dynasty He challenges the traditional and popularly accepted view of the Hongzhou School as a revolutionary movement that rejected mainstream mores and teachings charting a new path for Chan's independent growth as a unique Buddhist tradition This view he argues rests on a misreading of key elements of the Hongzhou School's history Rather than acting as an unorthodox movement the Hongzhou School's success was actually based largely on its ability to mediate tensions between traditionalist and iconoclastic tendencies Going beyond conventional romanticized interpretations that highlight the radical character of the Hongzhou School Poceski shows that there was much greater continuity between early and classical Chan and between the Hongzhou School and the rest of Tang Buddhism than previously thought
