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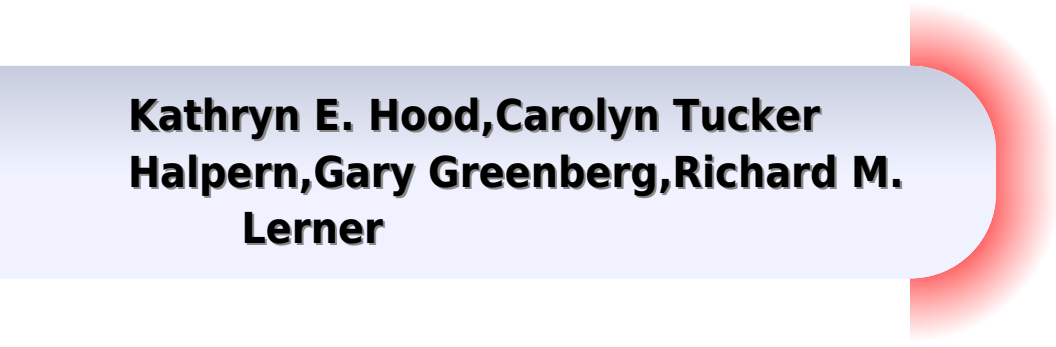

Mos, 2014-01-14 The intention of this paper is to review the evidence supporting the major thesis that a knowledge of genetic architecture within a species gives clues to the evolution of behavior To this end a study of some of the origins of this idea both within genetics and psychology will be embarked upon together with a review of the experimental evidence supportive of it This review will concentrate on behavioral phenotypes though not to the exclusion of other usually morphological character on which the original enunciation of the proposition was based Essentially the rationale is disarmingly simple The study of the gene action governing a behavioral or other characteristic by revealing the genetic architecture of the organism or species indicates the forces of natural selection which have moulded the genetic architecture in the way that it is observed today Thus natural selection leaves its imprint on the genome and it is argued that a sophisticated analysis of that genome in turn allows an inferential statement about the nature of those forces It will be at once apparent that the substructure for this type of argument is that of Darwinian evolutionary theory which is so widely and so pervasively accepted in contemporary biology that it seems hardly necessary to argue its case **Behavior Genetics** John L. A Model for Personality H.J. Eysenck, 2012-12-06 H J Eysenck This book is not an introduction to personality research it is not a textbook and above all it is not a model of personality The title A Model for Personality was chosen on purpose to indicate that we are here concerned with a discussion of how models in this field ought to be constructed what their functions were and whether such models or paradigms could with advantage be produced at this stage of development One particular aspect of personality extraversion introversion E has been chosen to exemplify the desiderata which emerge from such a discussion It is not suggested that personality and E are synonymous merely that this particular dimension is perhaps better known than any other has had more experimental work done on it than any other and has acquired a better theoretical substructure and more links with genetics and physiology than any other Hence it seems most likely to serve as an example of how a satisfactory model of personality might ultimately be constructed i e by analogy with E Other dimensions of personality such as neuroticism stability or psychoticism superego functioning are mentioned in the discussion but only when they overlap or interrelate with E The book uses E as an example to illustrate the way in which a model of personality can be constructed but it is in no way a summary of all that is known about E

Evolution of Longevity in Animals Avril Woodhead, 2013-03-07 The analysis of intra group correlations between LS and BW at representative intervals yields no consistent support for the hypothesis that lower BW is associated with longer LS Indeed among male Wistar rats and C57BL 6J and A J mice followed since weaning on AL diets the data suggested that relatively higher BW across the adult LS was

generally associated with longer life Even when the diet was restricted by EOD or RES regimens this pattern of positive correlations between LS and BW persisted for the C57BL 6J and A J strains when relative ages were analyzed However when BW at absolute ages were correlated with LS support for the positive relationship between BW and LS was not as forthcoming When AL groups were assessed beginning at later ages 10 months the pattern of positive correlations was very evident for the Wistar rats heavier rats tended to live longer This pattern was also evident among AL fed C57BL 6J mice followed since 6 months but was lost in the 10 month group in this strain Among A J mice on AL diets the pattern became somewhat negative when followed at 6 and 10 months of age However among both C57BL 6J and A J mice placed on EOD diets at 6 and 10 months of age the pattern clearly tended toward the positive
