Cognitive Linguistics and Lexical Change Natalya I. Stolova, 2015-03-27 This monograph offers the first in depth lexical and semantic analysis of motion verbs in their development from Latin to nine Romance languages Spanish French Italian Portuguese Romanian Catalan Occitan Sardinian and Raeto Romance demonstrating that the patterns of innovation and continuity attested in the data can be accounted for in cognitive linguistic terms At the same time the study illustrates how the insights gained from Latin and Romance historical data have profound implications for the cognitive approaches to language in particular for Leonard Talmy s motion framing typology and George Lakoff and Mark Johnson s conceptual metaphor theory The book should appeal to scholars interested in historical Romance linguistics cognitive linguistics and lexical change

Shared Grammaticalization Martine Irma Robbeets, Hubert Cuyckens, 2013 This book offers fresh perspectives on shared grammaticalization a state whereby two or more languages have the source and the target of a grammaticalization process in common While contact induced grammaticalization has generated great interest in recent years far less attention has been paid to other factors that may give rise to shared grammaticalization This book intends to put this situation right by approaching shared grammaticalization from an integrated perspective including areal as well as genealogical and universal motivations and by searching for ways to distinguish between these factors The volume offers a wealth of empirical facts presented by internationally renowned specialists on the Transeurasian languages i e Japonic Koreanic Tungusic Mongolic and Turkic the languages in focus as well as on various other languages Shared Grammaticalization will appeal to scholars and advanced students concerned with linguistic reconstruction language contact and linguistic typology and to anyone interested in grammaticalization theory

Grammatical Reconstruction Don Daniels, 2020-03-09 There is still widespread disagreement among historical linguists about how or whether syntactic reconstruction can be done This book presents a comprehensive methodology for syntactic reconstruction grounded in a constructional understanding of language The author then uses that methodology to reconstruct Proto Sogeram the ancestor to ten languages in Papua New Guinea Chapters are devoted to phonology lexicon verbal morphosyntax nominal morphosyntax and syntactic constructions The work culminates in a sketch of Proto Sogeram grammar Based largely on the author s original fieldwork this is an innovative application of a novel methodology to new data and the most complete reconstruction of a Papuan proto language to date It will be of interest to scholars of language change language reconstruction typology and Papuan languages

Competing Models of Linguistic Change Ole Nedergaard Thomsen, 2006-10-25 The articles of this volume are centered around two competing views on language change originally presented at the 2003 International Conference on Historical Linguistics in the two important plenary papers by Henning Andersen and William Croft The latter proposes an evolutionary model of language change within a domain neutral model of a generalized analysis of selection whereas Henning Andersen takes it that cultural phenomena could not possibly be handled

i e observed described understood in the same way as natural phenomena These papers are models of succinct presentation of important theoretical framework The other papers present and discuss additional models of change e g invisible hand processes system internal models functional and cognitive models Most papers do not subscribe to the evolutionary model instead they focus on functional factors in the selection and propagation of variants as opposed to factors of code efficiency or on cognitive and pragmatic perspectives Several papers are inspired by the late Eugenio Coseriu and by Henning Andersen s theories on language change In particular the volume contains articles proposing interesting grammaticalization studies and extended models of grammaticalization The clear presentation of important and competing approaches to fundamental questions concerning language change will be of high interest for scholars and students working in the field of diachrony and typology The languages referred to in the papers include Cantonese the Chukotko Kamchatkan languages Danish English Eskimo languages German Norwegian Russian Spanish and Swedish

Insubordination Nicholas Evans,Honoré Watanabe,2016-11-18 The phenomenon of insubordination can be defined diachronically as the recruitment of main clause structures from subordinate structures or synchronically as the independent use of constructions exhibiting characteristics of subordinate clauses Long marginalised as uncomfortable exceptions insubordinated clause phenomena turn out to be surprisingly widespread and provide a vital empirical testing ground for various central theoretical issues in current linguistics the interplay of langue and parole the emergence of structure the question of where productive syntactic rules give way to constructions the role of prosody in language change and the question of how far grammars are produced by isolated speakers as opposed to being collaboratively constructed in dialogue This volume the first book length treatment on the topic assembles studies of languages on all continents by scholars who bring a range of approaches to bear on the topic from historical linguistics to corpus studies to typology to conversational analysis
