

Research on the Design of Tourism Cultural and Creative Products from the Perspective of Semiotics

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Abstract. Under the background of cultural tourism economy, this paper explores the design methods of tourism cultural and creative products. Guided by the theory of semiotics three-in-one model, using FAHP and CRITIC model, combined with game theory, this paper screens and weighs cultural symbols, and discusses their application in tourism cultural and creative product design. Taking Caishiji as an example, this paper analyzes cultural symbols from four dimensions: shape, pattern, color and material, and applies them to the design practice of tourism cultural and creative products. The evaluation results show that this design method based on cultural symbols can effectively improve the design efficiency and scientificity, and the obtained tea set design scheme can also meet the needs of users. This study is of great significance for designers to understand and use regional symbols and improve the design effect of tourism cultural and creative products.

In recent years, the rapid development of cultural tourism economy has given birth to local cultural and creative industries, and tourism cultural and creative products have also become the research focus of scholars. The design research of tourism cultural and creative products is mainly carried out in two aspects: on the one hand, based on design theory, qualitative research is carried out from the generation mode and logic of cultural form symbols [1]. For example, Liu Yang et al. [2], Shi Aiqin et al. [3], Huang Wenqing et al. [4]; On the other hand, quantitative research based on user demand and big data drive discusses the design method of tourism cultural and creative products. For example, Yang Xiaoyan et al. [5], Xiao Derong et al. [6], Sun Binbin et al. [7]. Qualitative research is richer in explaining the formation of cultural content, but it lacks rational data support and insufficient conclusions. Quantitative research in the design practice of tourism cultural and creative products, it is more convincing to digitize design factors, but in practice, it lacks the guidance of design theory and is not logical. Therefore, taking the Caishiji scenic spot in Ma'anshan as an example, this paper intends to adopt the method of combining qualitative research with quantitative research, taking the semiotics triple integration model as the theoretical research basis, combining FAHP model, CRITIC model and game theory, and using fuzzy comprehensive evaluation method to verify the
