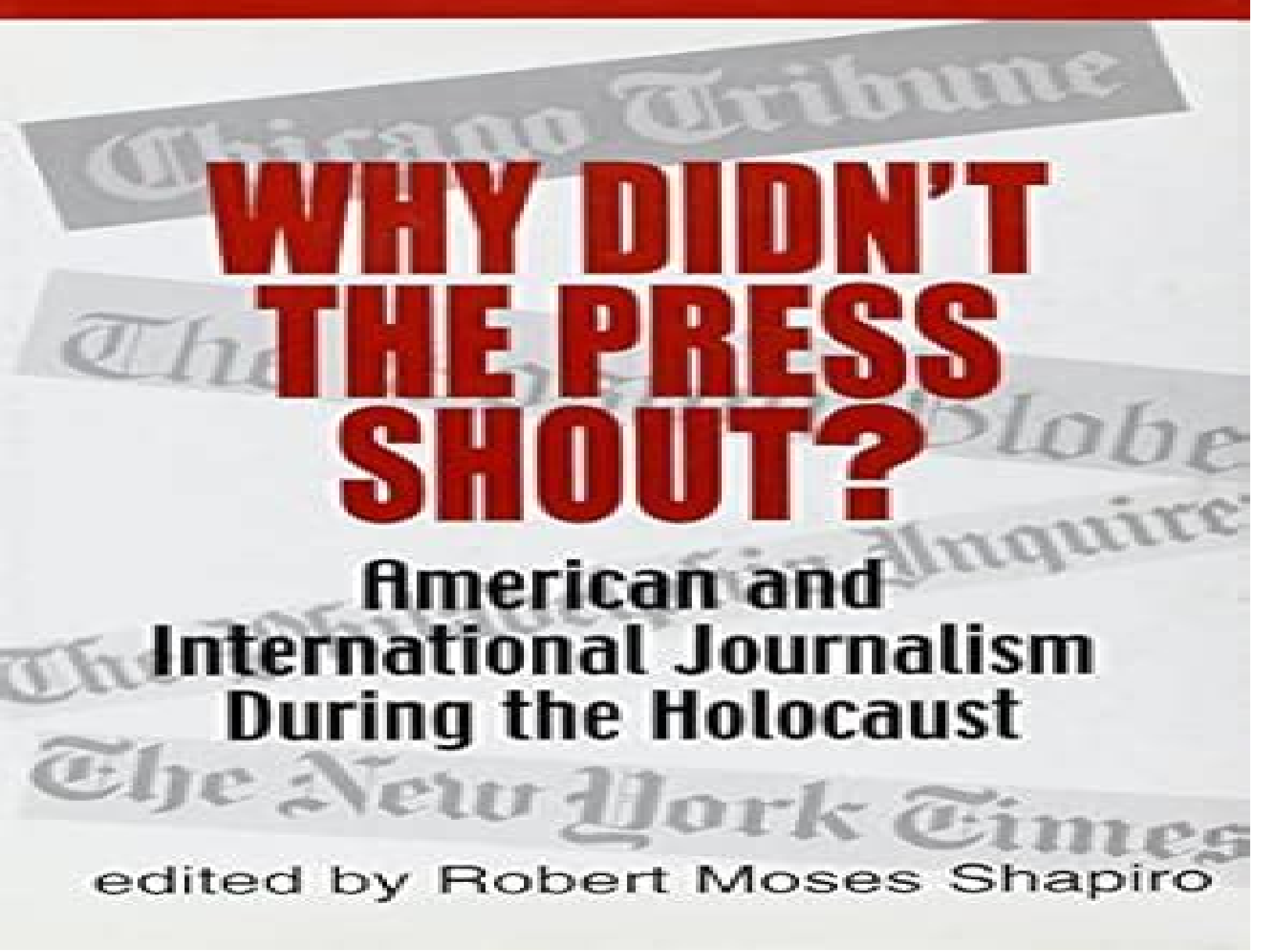

Why Didn't the Press Shout? Robert Moses Shapiro, 2003 This book brings together contributions by thirty scholars of journalism and history who look at what was reported about the Holocaust in the press of more than a dozen countries and languages The studies examine the news media in America England and the Soviet Union in Nazi Germany and Fascist Italy in the Vatican in occupied countries like Romania Hungary Greece and Poland and in Palestine under the British Mandate By and large the news media in the Allied countries neglected the story while those in Nazi dominated countries treated news related to the Holocaust in a wholly tendentious way Thus the press for a variety of reasons did not cover the Holocaust one of the central events of the twentieth century As this book thoroughly demonstrates it was perhaps the greatest ethical professional and political failure of the news media during World War II If the press had been more responsible and had informed the public in the West early enough and thoroughly enough the history of the Holocaust might have been different and millions of victims might have survived Published in association with Yeshiva University Press

**The Jewish Divide Over Israel** Paul Bogdanor, 2017-07-05 Before 1967 Israel had the overwhelming support of world opinion So long as Israel's existence was in harmony with politically correct assumptions it was supported or at least accepted by the majority of progressive Jews especially in the wake of the Holocaust This is no longer the case The Jewish Divide Over Israel explains the role played by prominent Jews in turning Israel into an isolated pariah nation After their catastrophic defeat in 1967 Arabs overcame inferiority on the battlefield with superiority in the war of ideas Their propaganda stopped trumpeting their desire to eradicate Israel Instead in a calculated appeal to liberals and radicals they redefined their war of aggression against the Jews as a struggle for the liberation of Palestinian Arabs The tenacity of Arabs rejection of Israel and their relentless campaign in schools universities churches professional organizations and above all the news media to destroy Israel's moral image had the desired impact Many Jewish liberals became desperate to escape from the shadow of Israel's alleged misdeeds and found a way to do so by joining other members of the left in blaming Israeli sins for Arab violence Today Jewish liberals rationalize violence against the innocent as resistance to the oppressor excuse Arab extremism as the frustration of a wronged party and redefine eliminationist rhetoric and physical assaults on Jews as criticism of Israeli policy Israel's Jewish accusers have played a crucial and disproportionate role in the current upsurge of antisemitism precisely because they speak as Jews The essays in this book seek to understand and throw back the assault on Israel led by such Jewish liberals and radicals as Tony Judt Noam Chomsky George Steiner Daniel Boyarin Marc Ellis Israel Shahak and many others Its writers demonstrate that the foundation of the state of Israel far from being the primal sin alleged by its accusers was one of the few redeeming events in a century of blood and shame

vast gorge located near Kyiv known as Babi Yar Babij Jar During and after the war the territory was modified redesigned and converted in order to remove the physical signs of genocide including the exhumation and incineration of thousands of bodies In large part this erasure was the result of policies implemented by the Soviet regime which refused to accept that there had been a special war against Jews Beginning with an explication of the mass murders and their aftermath Antonella Salomoni examines the afterlife of a massacre whose physical remains were intentionally hidden She focuses especially on how the arts prose poetry music architecture and painting shaped a collective narrative that despite repression played a crucial role in preserving the history and memory of the genocide *American Journalists in Hitler's Germany* Norman Domeier, 2025 The first book to critically examine American journalists and media companies roles in Hitler's Germany reigniting the debate on the relationship between political power and the media Despite Hitler's international use of propaganda and despite the power of the US press historians have neglected American journalists activity in Nazi Germany American media companies expanded their presence in Germany after 1933 and the Associated Press AP conducted business with Hitler's regime throughout the war Norman Domeier's study now in English is the first to examine critically and in detail the roles of American journalists and media companies in Hitler's Germany showing that they knew about but kept secret the plans for rearmament the occupation of the Rhineland the annexation of Austria the invasions of Denmark Norway and the Soviet Union The book documents the companionship between Adolf Hitler and Karl Henry von Wiegand chief German correspondent of the Hearst press who was the first and last American to interview him Most important it details the secret exchange of news photographs discovered by Domeier in 2017 between the AP and the Nazis from 1942-45 Thousands of AP photos were used in the Nazi press usually with anti American or anti Semitic spin while the AP distributed ca 40 000 Nazi photographs to US newspapers Domeier's book reignites the debate on the relationship between political power and the media opening up new perspectives on the political and cultural history of journalism beyond one sided idealizations

**Ballots, Babies, and Banners of Peace** Melissa R.
