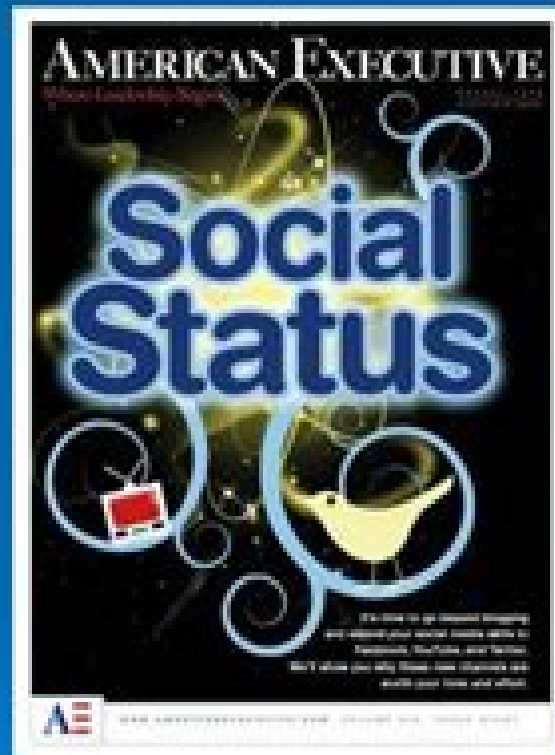
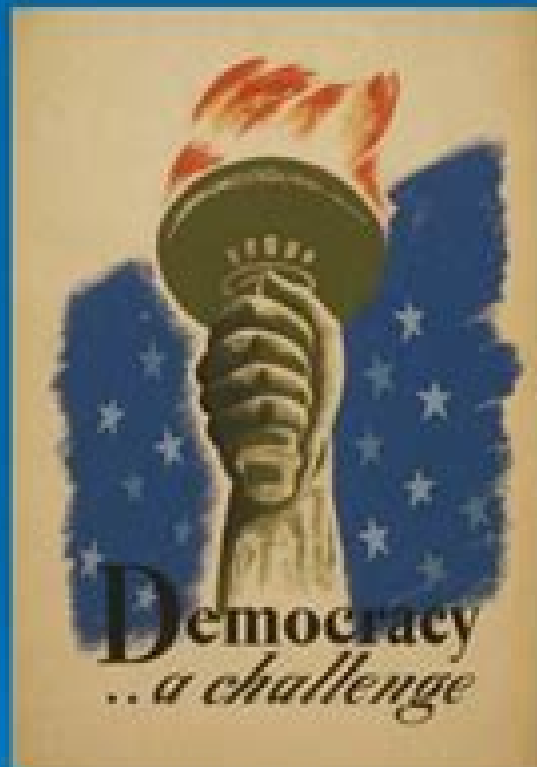

Their common theme is the notion popular with classical economists from Malthus to Mill that an economic stationary state is more healthful to life on earth than unlimited growth.
