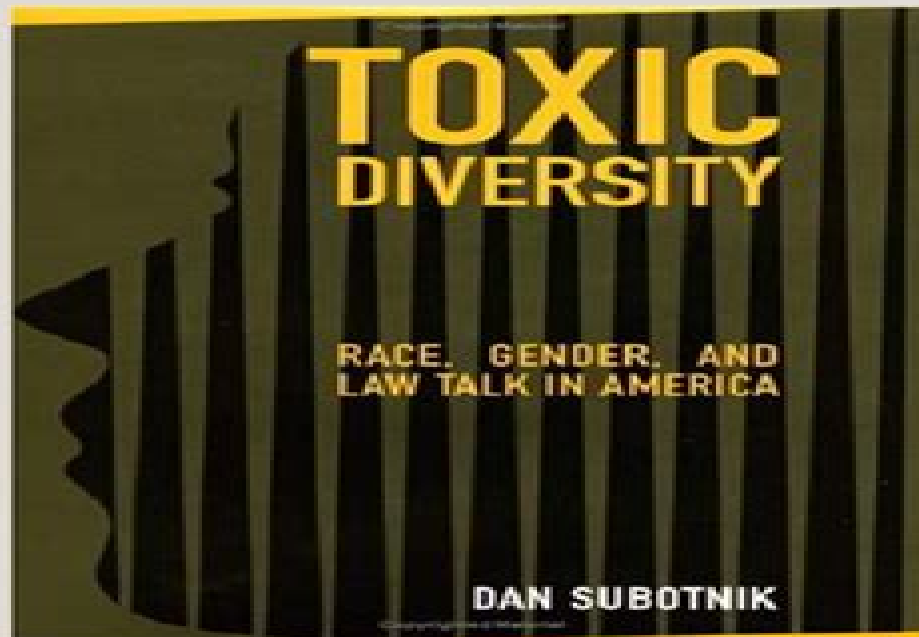

Gaming Sexism Amanda C. Cote, 2020-09-01 Interviews with female gamers about structural sexism across the gaming landscape When the Nintendo Wii was released in 2006 it ushered forward a new era of casual gaming in which video games appealed
