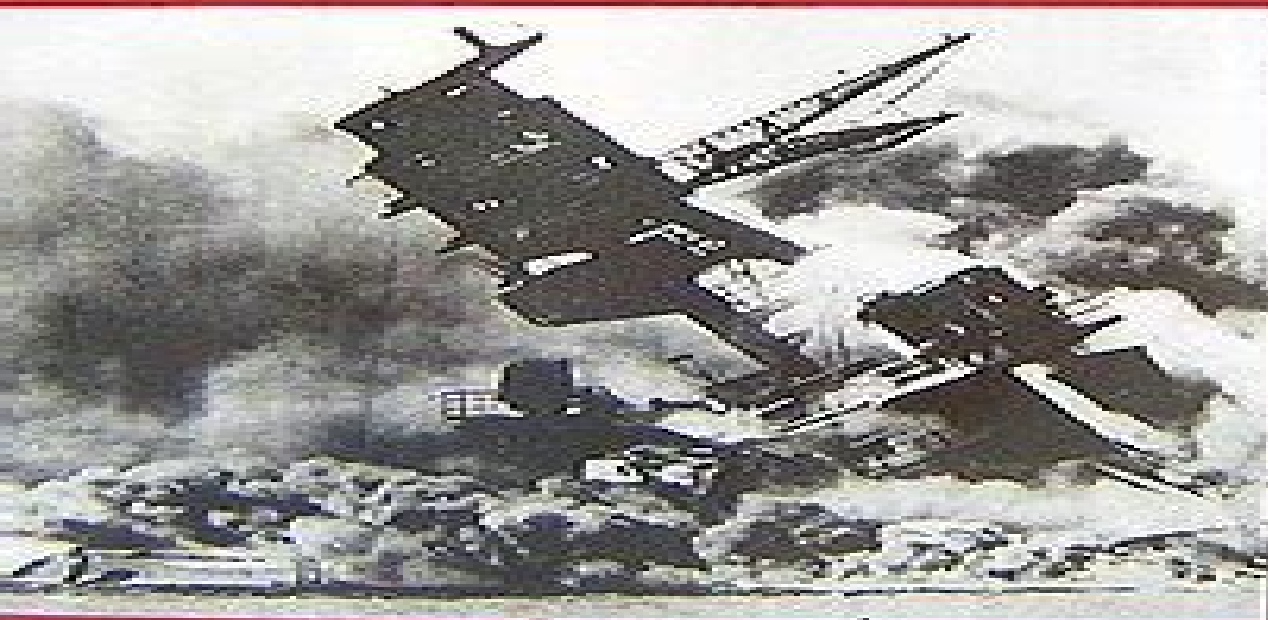

Nomonhan, 1939 Stuart Goldman, 2013-10-15 Stuart Goldman convincingly argues that a little known but intense Soviet Japanese conflict along the Manchurian Mongolian frontier at Nomonhan influenced the outbreak of World War II and shaped the course of the war The author draws on Japanese Soviet and western sources to put the seemingly obscure conflict actually a small undeclared war into its proper global geo strategic perspective The book describes how the Soviets in response to a border conflict provoked by Japan launched an offensive in August 1939 that wiped out the Japanese forces at Nomonhan At the same time Stalin signed the German Soviet Nonaggression Pact allowing Hitler to invade Poland The timing of these military and diplomatic strikes was not coincidental according to the author In forming an alliance with Hitler that left Tokyo diplomatically isolated Stalin succeeded in avoiding a two front war He saw the pact with the Nazis as a way to pit Germany against Britain and France leaving the Soviet Union on the sidelines to eventually pick up the spoils from the European conflict while at the same time giving him a free hand to smash the Japanese at Nomonhan Goldman not only demonstrates the linkage between the Nomonhan conflict the German Soviet Nonaggression Pact and the outbreak of World War II but also shows how Nomonhan influenced Japan's decision to go to war with the United States and thus change the course of history The book details Gen Georgy Zhukov's brilliant victory at Nomonhan that led to his command of the Red Army in 1941 and his success in stopping the Germans at Moscow with reinforcements from the Soviet Far East Such a

Snider, 2011-02-08 Over the past fifteen years Northeast Asia has witnessed growing intraregional exchanges and interactions especially in the realms of culture and economy Still the region cannot escape from the burden of history This book examines the formation of historical memory in four Northeast Asian societies China Japan South Korea and Taiwan and the United States focusing on the period from the beginning of the Sino Japanese war in 1931 until the formal conclusion of the Pacific War with the San Francisco Peace Treaty of 1951 The contributors analyse the recent efforts of Korean Japanese and Chinese scholars to write a common history of Northeast Asia and question the underlying motivations for their efforts and subsequent achievements In doing so

Ultrnationalism in German-Japanese Relations, 1930-1945

John Chapman,2011-04-06 This important new study focusing on the ultranationalist regimes in Germany and Japan during the 1930s and 1940s examines in biographical format the roles played by individuals significantly involved in the drive for global hegemony Employing a considerable range of new source materials and eyewitness testimony on the German side it highlights the roles of the Nazi Party enforcer and Gestapo representative in East Asia Josef Albert Meisinger and of the officer commanding German naval forces in the Pacific region Admiral Paul Werner Wenneker agent Richard Sorge as whose relations with the Japanese Navy in the 1930s were observed and recalled by Engineer Commander George C Ross the UK assistant naval attach in Japan The reactions of the German aero engineer Willi Foerster a client of the Soviet radio operator Max Clausen to both Meisinger and Wenneker in the 1940s are also documented On the Japanese side new evidence is employed which examines the influence of the right wing business and political figure Sasagawa Ry ichi on domestic events during the era of Tenn fascism and its aftermath Similarly an analysis of the role of the head of wartime Japanese military intelligence in eastern Europe General Onodera Makoto based in Stockholm indicates the extent of opposition within the Japanese army to factional groups wedded to Nazi ideology and strategy and the ongoing support in Japan for anti Soviet and anti communist policies in the post war era

War and Health Insurance Policy in Japan and the United States

Takakazu Yamagishi,2011-07-01 World War II forced extensive and comprehensive social and political changes on nations

across the globe This comparative examination of health insurance in the United States and Japan during and after the war explores how World War II shaped the health care systems of both countries To compare the development of health insurance in the two countries Takakazu Yamagishi discusses the impact of total war on four factors political structure interest group politics political culture and policy feedback During World War II the U S and Japanese governments realized that healthy soldiers workers mothers and children were vital to national survival While both countries adopted new expansive national insurance policies as part of their mobilization efforts they approached doing so in different ways and achieved near opposite results In the United States private insurance became the predominant means of insuring people save for a few government run programs Japan meanwhile created a near universal public insurance system After the war their different policy paths were consolidated Yamagishi argues that these disparate outcomes were the result of each nation s respective war experience He looks closely at postwar Japan and investigates how political struggles between the American occupation authority and U S domestic forces such as the American Medical Association helped solidify the existing Japanese health insurance system Original and tightly argued this volume makes a strong case for treating total war as a central factor in understanding how the health insurance systems of the two nations grew while bearing in mind the dual nature of government intervention however slight in health care Those interested in debates about health care in Japan the United States and other countries and especially scholars of comparative political development will appreciate and learn from Yamagishi s study

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
