side by side Kari and his handler grow inseparable through their travels in the Indian countryside As their adventures bring them to cities jungles and distant lands boy and elephant overcome danger and learn the true meaning of friendship Although he never returned to his native country Mukerji left an inspiring legacy through his literary achievement and unwavering commitment to Indian independence With a beautifully designed cover and professionally typeset manuscript this edition of Dhan Gopal Mukerji s Kari the Elephant is a classic of Indian American literature reimagined for modern readers
