Why Women Kill Vickie Jensen, 2001 Traditional homicide indicators are based on male violence and do little to predict when or whom women will kill Vickie Jensen shows that gender equality plays an important role in predicting female homicide patterns Jensen's analysis of the occurrence of women's homicide reveals that lethal violence is most likely when severe gender inequalities exist in the family group Her conclusions establish the clear relationship between political economic legal and social equality for women and the reduction of all forms of domestic violence Women on Trial Elizabeth A.
