Why Women Kill Vickie Jensen, 2001 Traditional homicide indicators are based on male violence and do little to predict when or whom women will kill Vickie Jensen shows that gender equality plays an important role in predicting female homicide patterns Jensen's analysis of the occurrence of women's homicide reveals that lethal violence is most likely when severe gender inequalities exist in the family group Her conclusions establish the clear relationship between political economic legal and social equality for women and the reduction of all forms of domestic violence *Defending Battered Women on Trial* Elizabeth A. responsible for injustice in the Global South Using the context of Zimbabwe it is shown that colonialism is not the only image of violence and injustice but that there are other forms of injustice that are of local origin Throughout the book it is argued that in speaking about contested criminalities writers call attention to the fact that laws are violated some laws are unjust and some crimes are henceforth justified In this sense crime in justice and the law are portrayed as unstable concepts
