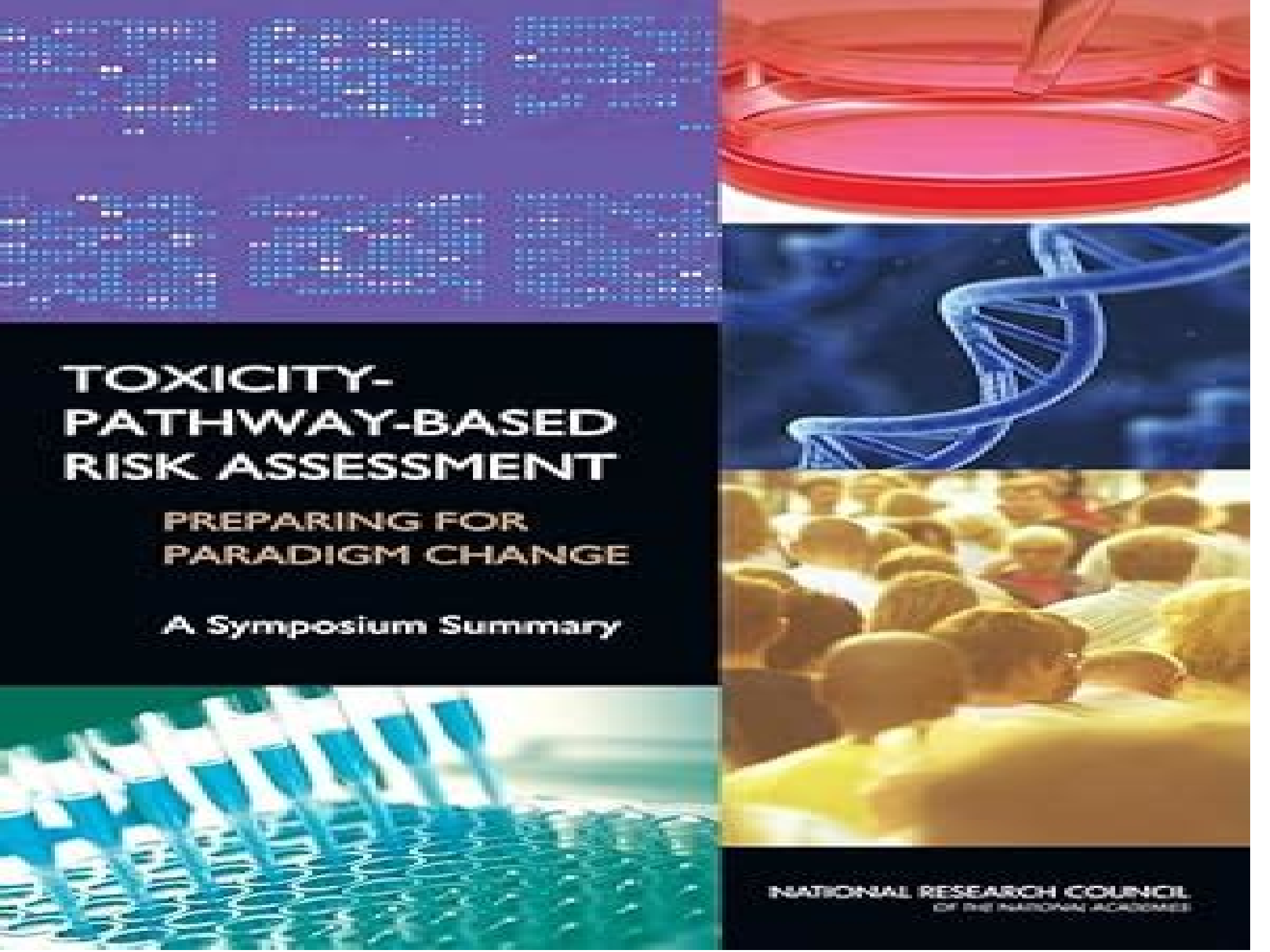

Toxicity-Pathway-Based Risk Assessment National Research Council, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Board on Environmental Studies and Toxicology, Standing Committee on Risk Analysis Issues and Reviews, 2010-06-07 In 2007 the National Research Council envisioned a new paradigm in which biologically important perturbations in key toxicity pathways would be evaluated with new methods in molecular biology bioinformatics computational toxicology and a comprehensive array of in vitro tests based primarily on human biology Although some considered the vision too optimistic with respect to the promise of the new science no one can deny that a revolution in toxicity testing is under way New approaches are being developed and data are being generated As a result the U S Environmental Protection Agency EPA expects a large influx of data that will need to be evaluated EPA also is faced with tens of thousands of chemicals on which toxicity information is incomplete and emerging chemicals and substances that will need risk assessment and possible regulation Therefore the agency asked the National Research Council to convene a symposium to stimulate discussion on the application of the new approaches and data in risk assessment The symposium was held on May 11 13 2009 in Washington DC and included presentations and discussion sessions on pathway based approaches for hazard identification applications of new approaches to mode of action analyses the challenges to and opportunities for risk assessment in the changing paradigm and future directions

Using 21st Century Science to Improve Risk-Related Evaluations National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Board on Environmental Studies and Toxicology, Committee on Incorporating 21st Century Science into Risk-Based Evaluations, 2017-03-16 Over the last decade several large scale United States and international programs have been initiated to incorporate advances in molecular and cellular biology omics technologies analytical methods bioinformatics and computational tools and methods into the field of toxicology Similar efforts are being pursued in the field of exposure science with the goals of obtaining more accurate and complete exposure data on individuals and populations for thousands of chemicals over the lifespan predicting exposures from use data and chemical property information and translating exposures between test systems and humans Using 21st Century Science to Improve Risk Related Evaluations makes recommendations for integrating new scientific approaches into risk based evaluations This study considers the scientific advances that have occurred following the publication of the NRC reports *Toxicity Testing in the 21st Century A Vision and a Strategy* and *Exposure Science in the 21st Century A Vision and a Strategy* Given the various ongoing lines of investigation and new data streams that have emerged this publication proposes how best to integrate and use the emerging results in evaluating chemical risk Using 21st Century Science to Improve Risk Related Evaluations considers whether a new paradigm is needed for data validation how to integrate the divergent data streams how uncertainty might need to be characterized and how best to communicate the new approaches so that they are understandable to various stakeholders

National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Board on Environmental Studies and Toxicology, Committee on Toxicology, Committee on Acute Exposure Guideline Levels, 2016-09-26 Extremely hazardous substances can be released accidentally as a result of chemical spills industrial explosions fires or accidents involving railroad cars and trucks transporting EHSs Workers and residents in communities surrounding industrial facilities where these substances are manufactured used or stored and in communities along the nation s railways and highways are potentially at risk of being exposed to airborne EHSs during accidental releases or intentional releases by terrorists Pursuant to the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 the U S Environmental Protection Agency EPA has identified approximately 400 EHSs on the basis of acute lethality data in rodents Acute Exposure Guideline Levels for Selected Airborne Chemicals Volume 20 reviews and updates the technical support document on acute exposure guideline levels AEGLs for selected chloroformates This update focuses on establishing AEGL 3 values for n propyl chloroformate and isopropyl chloroformate but will also consider whether any new data are available that would affect the proposed values for the other 10 chloroformates AEGLs represent threshold exposure limits exposure levels below which adverse health effects are not likely to occur for the general public and are applicable to emergency exposures ranging from 10 minutes min to 8 h Three levels AEGL 1 AEGL 2 and AEGL 3 are developed for each of five exposure periods 10 min 30 min 1 h 4 h and 8 h and are distinguished by varying degrees of severity of toxic effects This report will inform planning response and prevention in the community the workplace transportation the military and the remediation of Superfund sites

Controlled Human Inhalation-Exposure Studies at EPA National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Board on Environmental Studies and Toxicology, Committee on Assessing Toxicologic Risks to Human Subjects Used in Controlled Exposure Studies of Environmental Pollutants, 2017-04-10 The U S Environmental Protection Agency EPA has a mission and regulatory responsibility to protect human health and the environment EPA s pursuit of that goal includes a variety of research activities involving human subjects such as epidemiologic studies and surveys Those research activities also involve studies of individuals who volunteer to be exposed to air pollutants intentionally in controlled laboratory settings so that measurements can be made of transient and reversible biomarker or physiologic responses to those exposures that can indicate pathways of toxicity and mechanisms of air pollution responses The results of those controlled human inhalation exposure CHIE studies also referred to as human clinical studies or human challenge studies are used to inform policy decisions and help establish or revise standards to protect public health and improve air quality Controlled Human Inhalation Exposure Studies at EPA addresses scientific issues and provides guidance on the conduct of CHIE studies This report assesses the utility of CHIE studies to inform and reduce uncertainties in setting air pollution standards to protect public health and assess whether continuation of such studies is warranted It also evaluates the potential health risks to test subjects who participated in recent studies of air pollutants at EPA s clinical research facility
