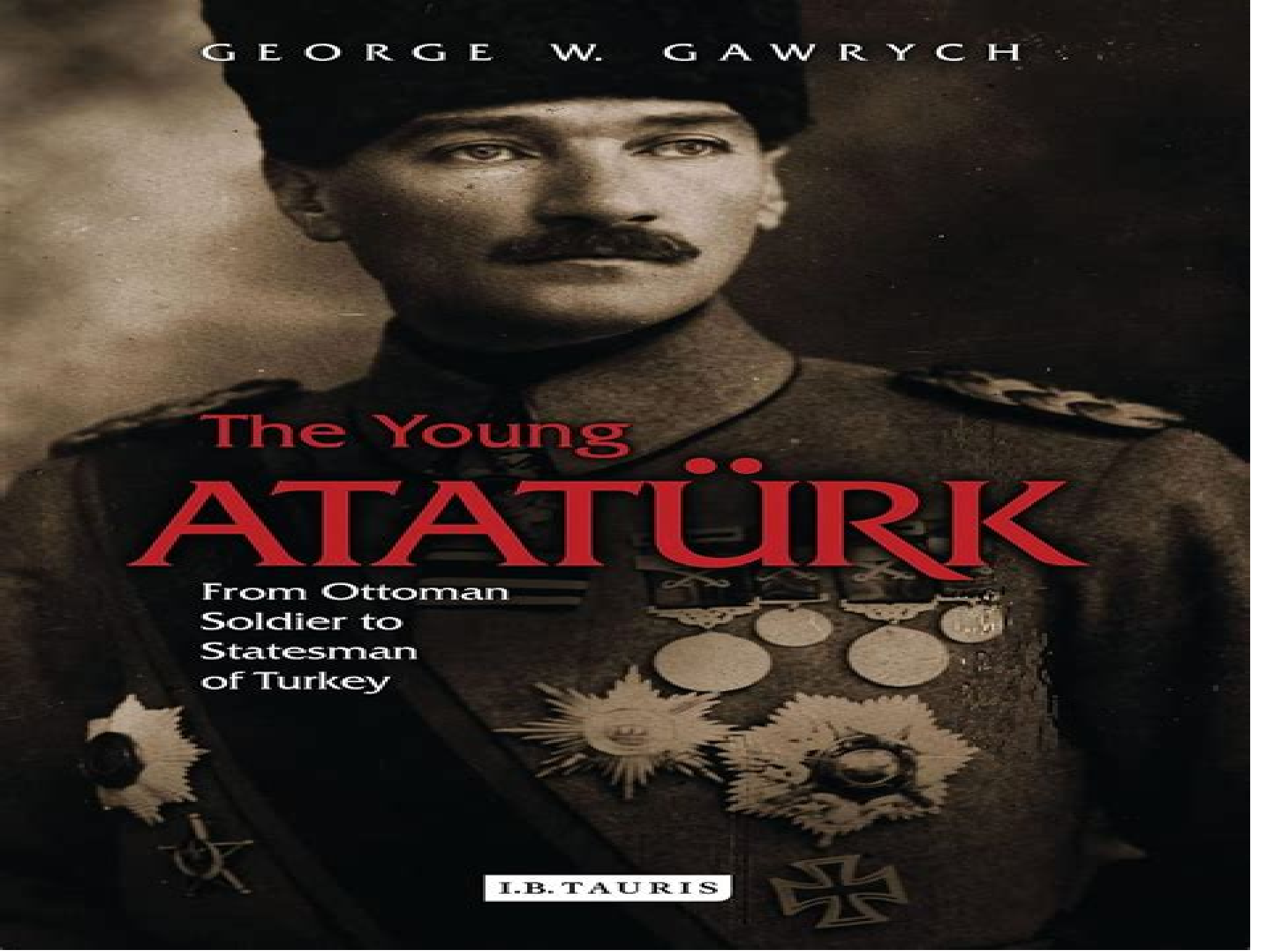

The Young Atatürk George W.
