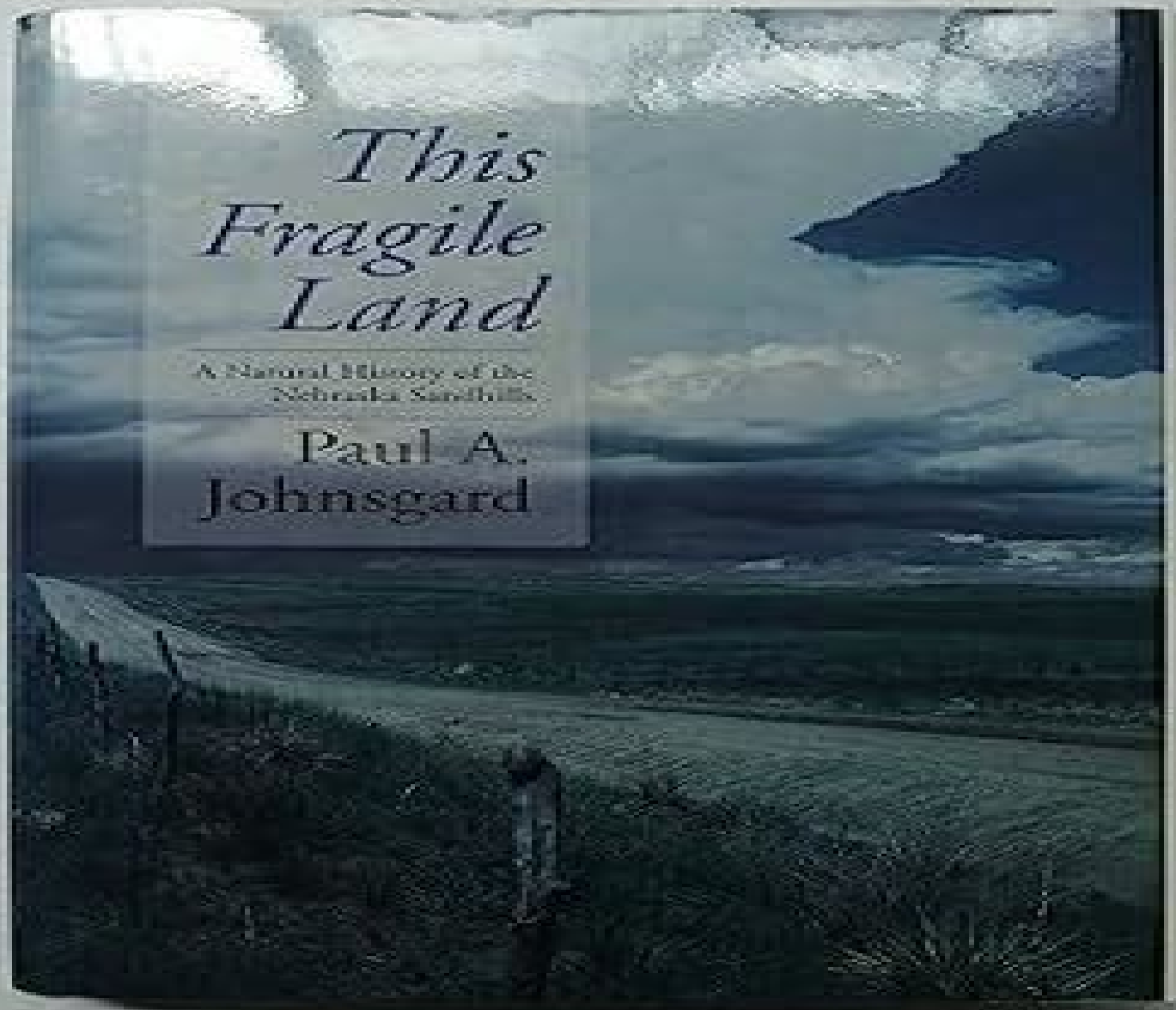

This Fragile Land Paul A. Johnsgard, 1995-01-01 The Nebraska Sandhills is the largest area of sand dunes in the western hemisphere covering an area about as large as Vermont New Hampshire and Rhode Island combined Unlike most dunes the Sandhills region supports an astonishing variety of wildlife Sixty million years ago the area lay submerged in a vast inland sea As the land lifted and the waters receded the sandhills were formed built upon a sandy floor above a sandy basement Paul A Johnsgard s appreciation for the region includes its evolution a process that continues today making a very special place patiently shaped by water wind and time Sometimes 450 feet higher than their sloping valleys the hills themselves are almost entirely covered with plants that manage to survive on an unstable substrate and in a climate of merciless heat and cold They provide homes and resting places for rare species and sustain the livelihoods of a remarkable variety of people Though firmly established in science this book is an extended love letter to the Sandhills region and its people plants and animals Johnsgard is now in his third decade of research in the Sandhills This Fragile Land lets others see what he sees a land with a fascinating range of geological biological and ecological vistas Paul A Johnsgard is Foundation Professor of the School of Biological Sciences at the University of Nebraska Lincoln Widely published throughout the English speaking world he has become a foremost authority on ornithology and bird behavior His thirty three books include Birds of the Great Plains The Platte Birds of the Rocky Mountains Those of the Gray Wind and Diving Birds of North America all available from the University of Nebraska Press The Nebraska Sandhills Monica Norby, Judy Diamond, Aaron Sutherlen, Sherilyn C. Leiker, Ramon Powers, 2012-11-09 The exodus of the Northern Cheyennes in 1878 and 1879 an attempt to flee from Indian Territory to their Montana homeland is an important event in American Indian history It is equally important in the history of towns like Oberlin Kansas where Cheyenne warriors killed more than forty settlers The Cheyennes in turn suffered losses through violent encounters with the U S Army More than a century later the story remains familiar because it has been told by historians and novelists and on film In The Northern Cheyenne Exodus in History and Memory James N Leiker and Ramon Powers explore how the event has been remembered told and retold They examine the recollections of Indians and settlers and their descendants and they consider local history mass media treatments and literature to draw thought provoking conclusions about how this story has changed over time The Cheyennes journey has always been recounted in melodramatic stereotypes and for the last fifty years most versions have featured noble savages trying to reclaim their birthright Here Leiker and Powers deconstruct those stereotypes and transcend them pointing out that history is never so simple The Cheyennes flight they write had left white and Indian bones alike scattered along its route from Oklahoma to Montana In this view the descendants of the Cheyennes

and the settlers they encountered are all westerners who need history as a way of explaining the bones and arrowheads that littered the plains Leiker and Powers depict a rural West whose diverse peoples Euro American and Native American alike seek to preserve their heritage through memory and history Anyone who lives in the contemporary Great Plains or who wants to understand the West as a whole will find this book compelling *The Birds of Nebraska* Paul Johnsgard,2018-07-06 This annotated list of the birds of Nebraska grew gradually out of research associated with my writing of the *Birds of the Great Plains Breeding Species and Their Distribution* Johnsgard 1979a It expands and updates an earlier version that was published in 2013 by the University of Nebraska Lincoln Libraries DigitalCommons Zea Books Johnsgard 2013a It has been updated and modified in its current revision to conform with the most recent 2017 major revision of the American Ornithologists Society's Checklist of North American Birds Chesser et al 2017 It has also been modified in its current revision to conform very closely to the most recent Official List of the Birds of Nebraska by the Nebraska Ornithologists Union Gubanyi 1997 and later supplements in the Nebraska Bird Review to 84 138 150 The NOU's official state list of birds 461 species as of 2017 is based on actual specimen evidence or some other convincing basis of each species proven occurrence in the state That list includes 337 regular species 29 casual species 90 accidental species and 5 extinct or extirpated species In this edition I have classified 368 of the 461 species of Nebraska birds as ranging in relative frequency of occurrence as abundant to rare There are also 61 species considered to be of accidental occurrence having been reliably reported in Nebraska no more than five times 20 that are considered extremely rare or very rare if reported from six to 25 times There are also three extinct four extirpated and five unsuccessfully introduced species Thirteen hypothetical species of dubious origin or identification are mentioned parenthetically The text includes more than 123 000 words nearly 200 literature references and 19 pages of drawings and maps **Great Wildlife of the Great Plains** Paul A.
