The Reappeared Rebekah Park, 2014-09-22 Between 1976 and 1983 during a period of brutal military dictatorship armed forces in Argentina abducted 30 000 citizens These victims were tortured and killed never to be seen again Although the history of los desaparecidos the disappeared has become widely known the stories of the Argentines who miraculously survived their imprisonment and torture are not well understood The Reappeared is the first in depth study of an officially sanctioned group of Argentine former political prisoners the Association of Former Political Prisoners of Cordoba which organized in 2007 Using ethnographic methods anthropologist Rebekah Park explains the experiences of these survivors of state terrorism and in the process raises challenging questions about how societies define victimhood what should count as a human rights abuse and what purpose memorial museums actually serve The men and women who reappeared were often ostracized by those who thought they must have been collaborators to have survived imprisonment but their actual stories are much more complex Park explains why the political prisoners waited nearly three decades before forming their own organization and offers rare insights into what motivates them to recall their memories of solidarity and resistance during the dictatorial past even as they suffer from the long term effects of torture and imprisonment The Reappeared challenges readers to rethink the judicial and legislative aftermath of genocide and forces them to consider how much reparation is actually needed to compensate for unimaginable and lifelong suffering

voca Reconciliation Barometer data All the authors seek to contribute to our understanding of the role of women in conflict and beyond the relationship between peace and justice and the nexus between reconciliation and trust **Sustaining the Borderlands in the Age of NAFTA** Suzanne Simon,2014-06-20 Sustaining the Borderlands in the Age of NAFTA provides the only book length study of the impact on residents of the US Mexico border of NAFTA s Environmental and Labor Side Accords which required each state to enforce labor and environmental regulations Through field research in Matamoros Tamaulipas anthropologist Suzanne Simon tests the premise that the side accords would encourage Mexican grassroots democratization The effectiveness of the side accords was tied to transparency and accountability and practically bound to opportunities for Mexican border populations to participate in the side accord petitioning and civil society input mechanisms Simon conducted sixteen months of fieldwork with both a group of environmental activists and a group of those fighting for labor justice in Mexico Both of these groups became enmeshed in the types of cross border advocacy networks and coalition building efforts that are typical of the NAFTA era Although the key to the side accords anticipated success lay in their ostensibly generous participatory civil society inclusion and sustainable development opportunities Sustaining the Borderlands reveals that the Mexican border populations for which they were largely created are effectively excluded from participating This is due to the ongoing online territorial class and cultural barriers that shape the borderlands Rather than experiencing the side accords and their companion institutions as transparent and accessible residents experienced them as opaque and indecipherable Simon concludes that the side accords have failed to deliver on their promise of bringing democracy to Mexico because practical mechanisms that would ensure their effective implementation were never put in place NAFTA took effect at a time when Mexico was undergoing a democratic transition The treaty was supposed to encourage this transition and improve environmental and labor conditions on the US Mexico border This book demonstrates that twenty years later the promises of NAFTA have not come to pass *Democracy, Electoral Systems, and Judicial Empowerment in Developing Countries* Vineeta Yadav,Bumba Mukherjee,2014-03-20 An independent judiciary is considered

Participatory Budgeting in Brazil Brian Wampler,2010-11 As Brazil and other countries in Latin America turned away from their authoritarian past and began the transition to democracy in the 1980s and 1990s interest in developing new institutions to bring the benefits of democracy to the citizens in the lower socioeconomic strata intensified and a number of experiments were undertaken Perhaps the one receiving the most attention has been Participatory Budgeting PB first launched in the southern Brazilian city of Porto Alegre in 1989 by a coalition of civil society activists and Workers Party officials PB quickly spread to more than 250 other municipalities in the country and it has since been adopted in more than twenty countries worldwide Most of the scholarly literature has focused on the successful case of Porto Alegre and has

neglected to analyze how it fared elsewhere In this first rigorous comparative study of the phenomenon Brian Wampler draws evidence from eight municipalities in Brazil to show the varying degrees of success and failure PB has experienced He identifies why some PB programs have done better than others in achieving the twin goals of ensuring governmental accountability and empowering citizenship rights for the poor residents of these cities in the quest for greater social justice and a well functioning democracy Conducting extensive interviews applying a survey to 650 PB delegates doing detailed analysis of budgets and engaging in participant observation Wampler finds that the three most important factors explaining the variation are the incentives for mayoral administrations to delegate authority the way civil society organizations and citizens respond to the new institutions and the particular rule structure that is used to delegate authority to citizens
