Visual Attention and Consciousness Jay Friedenber, 2013 This book is an ambitious interdisciplinary survey of the empirical literature on many different aspects of visual attention and consciousness It may be used as a primary or ancillary text for graduate courses in perception vision consciousness or philosophy of mind Consciousness, Attention, and Conscious Attention Carlos Montemayor, Harry Haroutioun Haladjian, 2015-04-17 A rigorous analysis of current empirical and theoretical work supporting the argument that consciousness and attention are largely dissociated In this book Carlos Montemayor and Harry Haladjian consider the relationship between consciousness and attention The cognitive mechanism of attention has often been compared to consciousness because attention and consciousness appear to share similar qualities But Montemayor and Haladjian point out attention is defined functionally whereas consciousness is generally defined in terms of its phenomenal character without a clear functional purpose They offer new insights and proposals about how best to understand and study the relationship between consciousness and attention by examining their functional aspects The book's ultimate conclusion is that consciousness and attention are largely dissociated Undertaking a rigorous analysis of current empirical and theoretical work on attention and consciousness Montemayor and Haladjian propose a spectrum of dissociation a framework that identifies the levels of dissociation between consciousness and attention ranging from identity to full dissociation They argue that conscious attention the focusing of attention on the contents of awareness is constituted by overlapping but distinct processes of consciousness and attention Conscious attention they claim evolved after the basic forms of attention increasing access to the richest kinds of cognitive contents Montemayor and Haladjian's goal is to help unify the study of consciousness and attention across the disciplines A focused examination of conscious attention will they believe enable theoretical progress that will further our understanding of the human mind **The Conscious Brain** Jesse J. Prinz, 2012-08-17 The problem of consciousness continues to be a subject of great debate in cognitive science Synthesizing decades of research *The Conscious Brain* advances a new theory of the psychological and neurophysiological correlates of conscious experience Prinz's account of consciousness makes two main claims first consciousness always arises at a particular stage of perceptual processing the intermediate level and second consciousness depends on attention Attention changes the flow of information allowing perceptual information to access memory systems Neurobiologically this change in flow depends on synchronized neural firing Neural synchrony is also implicated in the unity of consciousness and in the temporal duration of experience Prinz also explores the limits of consciousness We have no direct experience of our thoughts no experience of motor commands and no experience of a conscious self All consciousness is perceptual and it functions to make perceptual information available to systems that allows for flexible behavior Prinz concludes by discussing prevailing philosophical puzzles He provides a neuroscientifically grounded response to the leading argument for dualism and argues that materialists need not choose between functional and neurobiological approaches but can instead combine these into

neurofunctional response to the mind body problem The Conscious Brain brings neuroscientific evidence to bear on enduring philosophical questions while also surveying challenging and extending philosophical and scientific theories of consciousness All readers interested in the nature of consciousness will find Prinz s work of great interest From Perception to Consciousness Jeremy Wolfe,Lynn Robertson,2011-12-29 Anyone interested in the study of attention will have had some exposure to the work of Anne Treisman Anne Treisman has been one of the most influential cognitive psychologists in the last 50 years Her research and theoretical insights have influenced a variety of disciplines including vision sciences auditory sciences cognitive psychology cognitive neurosciences philosophy psychiatry neuropsychology and behavioral neurology She is best known for her work on attention Early in her career much of that work involved auditory stimuli Her later work has been primarily in the realm of visual attention She has been especially concerned with the interactions among visual perception attention and memory as they relate to conscious and unconscious experience Her Feature Integration Theory has been one of the organizing ideas in the field for three decades While still a graduate student at Oxford she helped launch the modern study of attention In the present volume several of her most influential papers are reprinted including some of the harder to find early work To accompany these reprints the editors invited experts to comment and or to show how their own work had been shaped by Treisman s ideas and findings The result is a scientifically rich ride through the world of ideas inspired by Treisman s work The contributed chapters include discussions of auditory and visual attention the role of features in selection parallel and serial processing and automaticity They describe the roots and evolution of Feature Integration Theory and related models like Guided Search They explore the interactions of attention and perception at the cognitive neuropsychological and biological levels Readers can consider the critical role of binding in perception the role of attention in scene perception as well as the influence of cognitive load memory reflection and perceptual learning on early and late processing They will see how methods to study conscious perceptual awareness have evolved over the years **Attention and consciousness in different senses** Naotsugu Tsuchiya,Jeroen J. Van Boxtel,2013-06-03 Although often used in everyday speech and in the scholarly literature selective attention and consciousness lack clear undisputed definitions Partly because of this deficit there exists a lively debate on the relationship between the two Nevertheless attention has been studied scientifically for a long time because a variety of tasks allow researchers to control several of its aspects e g focused and feature based attention Consciousness as a scientific subject of study has emerged more recently but is now rapidly gaining traction Scientific studies of consciousness concern the state or level of consciousness e g awake as opposed to in coma dreamless sleep or under anaesthesia as well as the contents of consciousness or the phenomenology of perception With the increase in consciousness focused research there is a concomitant surge in research examining the relationship between attention and consciousness This relationship between attention and consciousness is the topic of this Research Topic Contributions related to or focused solely on attention or on consciousness will not be considered It had long been

assumed that attention and consciousness are inextricably intertwined two sides of the same coin However recently substantial evidence has emerged that attention and consciousness are interacting but separable processes It is however debated how tight the interactions are and what the exact nature of the relationship is Therefore we invite researchers from different camps to provide opinionated but balanced literature reviews Different groups will interpret the same data in different ways We feel that combining these views in one Research Topic is immensely valuable to researchers from different fields Apart from reviews we also invite potential contributors to provide new and exciting evidence in the form of original contributions that may support any of the different views Even though attention and consciousness are critical aspects of many different cognitive processes they are mainly studied though not exclusively in the domain of visual perception In other sensory modalities e g olfaction or audition it is currently not clear whether distinctions between attention and consciousness exist which is even more true for other cognitive processes such as memory Therefore we specifically invite contributions covering the auditory somatosensory olfactory and memory domain We ask all contributors to provide discussions on the relationship between attention and consciousness and focus on 1 the influence of attention on sensory processing 2 the formation of conscious perception 3 the evidence for unconscious processing and its modulation by attention 4 potential indications for dissociations between attention and consciousness e g does paying attention to a stimulus decrease performance on e g a discrimination task 5 neuroimaging and neurophysiology data pertaining to these questions Often one is caught in one s own research field and lacks the time or the knowledge to delve into another field This Research Topic should provide a great overview in great breadth of the current state of knowledge on the links between attention and consciousness and their interactions in several different sensory modalities
