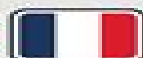

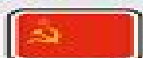

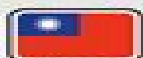

CAUSES

Treaty of Versailles

The harsh conditions imposed on Germany following World War I spurred the rise of Nazism.

Great Depression

The economic crisis fueled nationalist and militaristic rhetoric in Europe.

Expansionism

Nazi Germany, Fascist Italy and Japan sought territorial expansion.

Molotov-Ribbentrop Pact

The non-aggression pact between Germany and the USSR facilitated the German invasion of Poland.

CONSEQUENCES

Destruction

Bombing raids destroyed entire cities in Europe and Japan.

Redrawing of the map

The aggressor powers lost part of their territories.

United Nations

The UN was established to ensure international security.

Decolonization

Europe's decline paved the way for decolonization of Asia and Africa.

Cold War

Europe was divided into two blocs: the Western Bloc, led by the United States, and the Eastern Bloc, led by the USSR.

- The war began with the German invasion of Poland, then spreading to the rest of the world.
 - The main theaters of war were Europe, the Mediterranean, and the Pacific.
 - The entry of the USSR and the United States into the war was decisive for the Allied victory.
 - It was the only war in which nuclear weapons were used, in the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
 - The war ended with the unconditional surrender of Germany and Japan.

Allied Conferences

During the war, the Allies held meetings to agree on strategic decisions and outline conditions for peace.

CASABLANCA CONFERENCE

Commitment to demand the unconditional surrender of the Axis powers.

TEHRAN CONFERENCE

Consensus to open a second front in France.

YALTA CONFERENCE

Redrawing of new borders and laying down conditions for Germany.

POTSDAM CONFERENCE

Agreement to divide Germany and Austria into four occupation zones.

Holocaust



The Nazis implemented a plan to exterminate the European Jewish population known as the "Final Solution." Extermination camps were built mainly in Poland, in which mass killing methods such as mass shootings and gas chambers were used. Concentration camps were established, where groups considered enemies of the state were imprisoned under brutal and inhumane conditions. This resulted in the death of 11 million people, including 6 million of Jewish origin.
