The Welfare State and Social Work Pursuing Social Justice critically assesses the historical, sociopolitical, and economic factors that have influenced social work policy and practice in the United States. By viewing social welfare and social work in light of principles of social justice, author Josefina Figueira-McDonough offers a fresh perspective on this interplay and how this interaction affects policy and practice.

Key Features:

- **Offers a social justice framework:** Analytical frameworks sharpen students' skills regarding public policies and professional codes. This book conceptualizes social justice as it operates—or fails to operate—under a specific system: the liberal democracy familiar to citizens of the United States.
- **Addresses the dimensions of recent policies:** The book examines how administrative centralization and political and economic power affect social policies, how these policies are conditioned by the paths embedded in the histories of previous decisions, and how a selective ideology justifies them.
- **Provides a critical commentary:** The interplay between power, path dependence, and ideology provides the common frame for the historical account of the development of social policy and social work. This book offers critical commentary following coverage of historical periods.
- **Examines the cumulative effects of policies on minorities:** Students are made aware of the concrete impact of policies on the "haves" and "have-nots." The book also systematically compares outcomes in the United States with those in other liberal democracies that have different welfare regimes and evaluates proposals for reforming welfare in a global context.

It is also an excellent supplement for a variety of courses on inequality, poverty, and citizenship.
