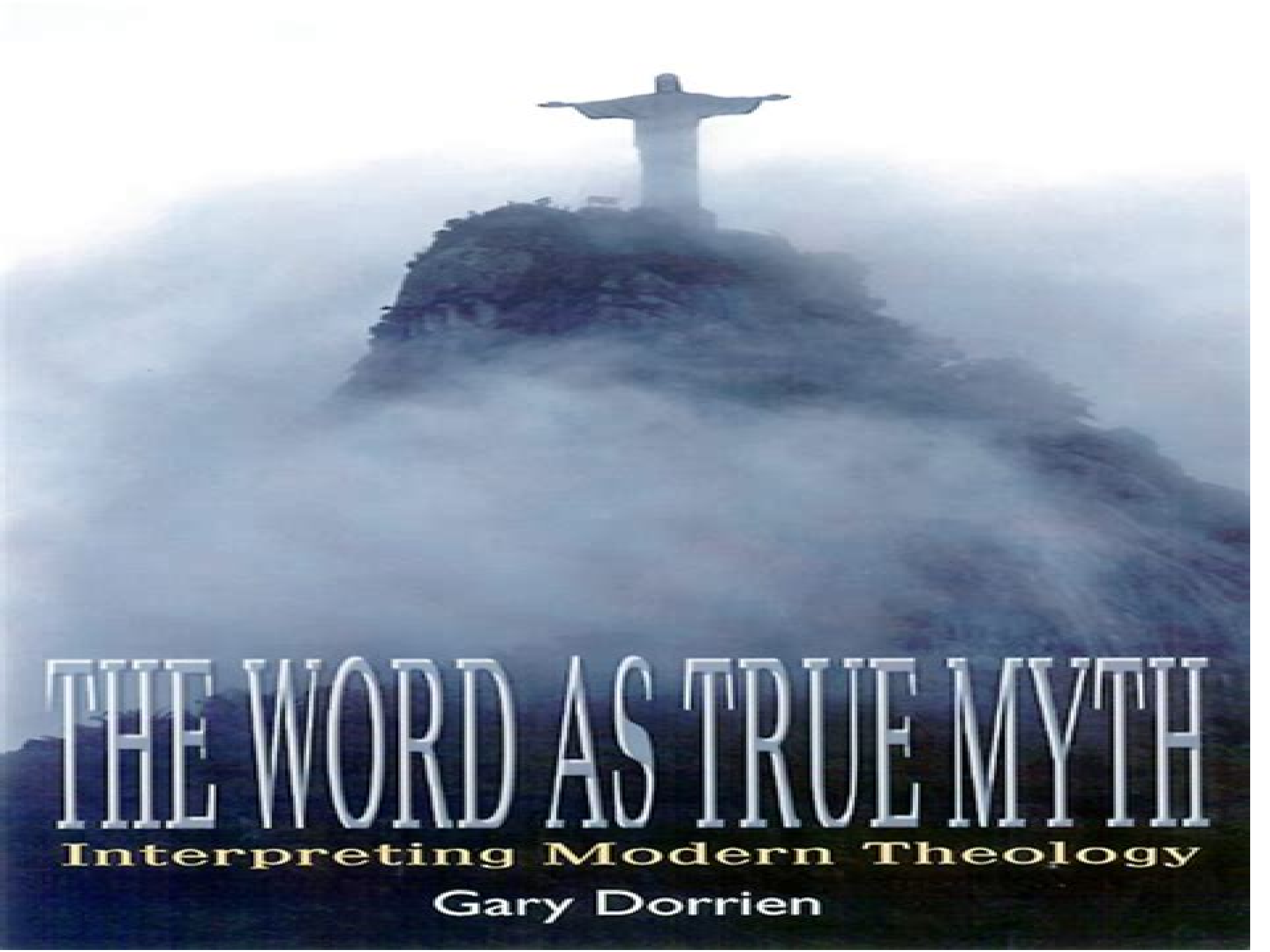

The Word as True Myth Gary J. Dorrien, 1997-01-01 Gary Dorrien follows the threads of theology through the twentieth century examining how Christians have reconciled their myth filled religious beliefs within a world secularized by Enlightenment criticism and science To understand how religion keeps its place in Christians lives Dorrien writes we must explore how modern theologians have answered the question of myth in today s Christianity Dorrien s narrative walks readers through modern theology stopping with each of the major thinkers along the way to see how they dealt with the issue of modern Christian mythology Ultimately he offers his own new neo orthodoxy a theology of Word and Spirit that is pluralistic and affirms the mythical character of the gospel while holding fast to the Gospels myth negating condemnation of idolatry and their focus on history
