Noble argues conventional characterizations of the Priestly writers' view of covenant have failed to take into account the significance of these two non-chosen figures. His ambiguous status calls for reconsideration of the goals and values of the Priestly work, which Noble sketches around themes of covenant, fertility, life, and the future of nations.

The contention of this book is that this doctrine has no biblical grounds and is rationally unfounded, and that Arminianism itself stands or falls on this doctrine.
