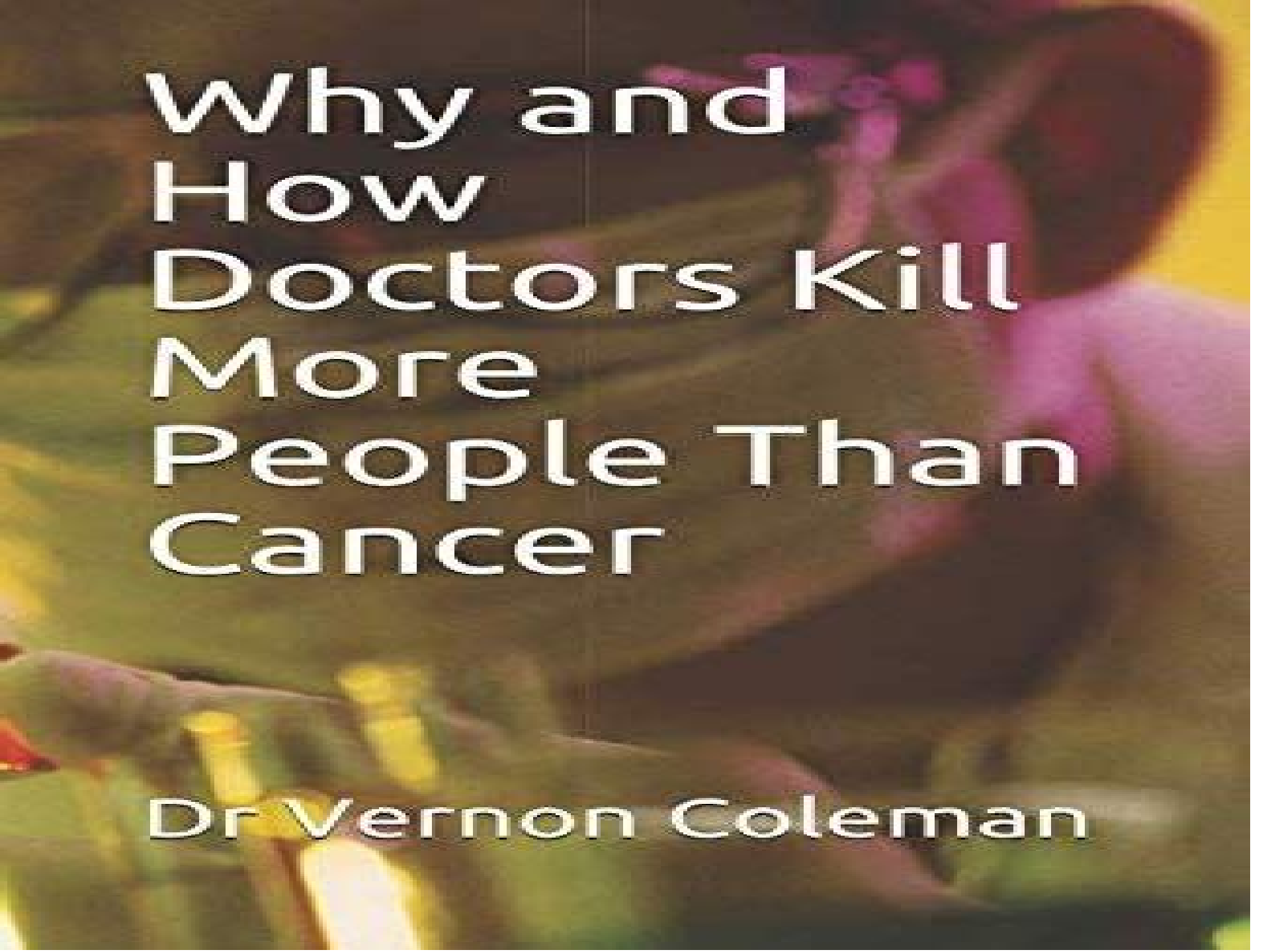

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The Law and Ethics of Medicine John Keown, 2012-04-26 The Law and Ethics of Medicine Essays on the Inviolability of Human Life explains the principle of the inviolability of human life and its continuing relevance to English law governing aspects of medical practice at the beginning and end of life The book shows that the principle though widely recognized as an historic and foundational principle of the common law has been misunderstood in

the legal academy at the Bar and on the Bench Part I of the book identifies the confusion and clarifies the principle distinguishing it from vitalism on the one hand and a qualitative evaluation of human life on the other Part II addresses legal aspects of the beginning of life including the history of the law against abortion and its relevance to the ongoing abortion debate in the US the law relating to the morning after pill and the legal status of the human embryo in vitro Part III addresses legal aspects of the end of life including the euthanasia debate the withdrawal of tube feeding from patients in a persistent vegetative state and the duty to provide palliative treatment This unique collection of essays offers a much needed clarification of a cardinal legal and ethical principle and should be of interest to lawyers bioethicists and healthcare professionals whether they subscribe to the principle or not in all common law jurisdictions and beyond

Debating Euthanasia Emily Jackson, John Keown, 2011-12-02 In this new addition to the Debating Law series Emily Jackson and John Keown re examine the legal and ethical aspects of the euthanasia debate Emily Jackson argues that we owe it to everyone in society to do all that we can to ensure that they experience a good death For a small minority of patients who experience intolerable and unrelievable suffering this may mean helping them to have an assisted death In a liberal society where people's moral views differ we should not force individuals to experience deaths they find intolerable This is not an argument in favour of dying On the contrary Jackson argues that legalisation could extend and enhance the lives of people whose present fear of the dying process causes them overwhelming distress John Keown argues that voluntary euthanasia and physician assisted suicide are gravely unethical and he defends their continued prohibition by law He analyses the main arguments for relaxation of the law including those which invoke the experience of jurisdictions which permit these practices and finds them wanting Relaxing the law would he concludes be both wrong in principle and dangerous in practice not least for the dying the disabled and the disadvantaged
