Stephanie Bruno, 2011 One block at a time this guidebook offers an expert's perspective on the architectural diversity and details of New Orleans unique neighborhoods A walk through the streets of the city takes one down brick sidewalks and past the ancient Creole cottages in the Vieux Carré stately townhouses in the American Sector Garden District center halls and ubiquitous shotguns The walker passes along avenues lined with homes draped in the ornamentation typical of the Greek Revival Italianate and Craftsman styles and through neighborhoods distinguished by milled brackets arched top windows and clean horizontal lines New Orleans is a city of extraordinary variety and style and this volume enables the casual tourist and lifelong resident alike the opportunity to walk down her blocks and appreciate the extraordinary architectural backdrop With authority and verve architectural historian and popular columnist R Stephanie Bruno guides each reader through the brightly colored and diverse streets of New Orleans as she explores step by step the architectural details of the houses and the individual choices their owners have made to change each one during the course of renovations In each neighborhood Bruno highlights variations in architectural details and identifies elements of each house allowing readers to recognize different architectural styles and even decide what type of house they would most like to inhabit from publisher's website **New Orleans Architecture** Robert J. Cangelosi, Jr., 2020-12-02 An essential reference guide to one of New Orleans's most iconic Uptown neighborhoods New Orleans Architecture Volume IX documents the remarkable architectural history of the former city of Carrollton once the seat of Jefferson Parish and now listed on the National Register of Historic Places Following the format of previous volumes in the series Robert J Cangelosi Jr divides the study into three sections He begins in the early eighteenth century by chronicling the area's development as one of the many upriver communities just west of New Orleans Its fields and plantations afforded early homesteaders tillable farmland and easy access to the Mississippi River Later during the War of 1812 American troops led by William Carroll encamped there and the area was subsequently named for the general In 1831 developers purchased the land subdivided it and began construction of a road and a canal linking the area to New Orleans Local officials reorganized Carrollton in 1845 by then a village of about 1 000 residents as a town in Jefferson Parish and in 1859 a charter officially incorporated it as a city Just fifteen years later the City of New Orleans annexed Carrollton now replete with schools public gardens and brick paved streets as the Seventh Municipal District The volume's second section consists of a Building Index which gives the original owners dates of construction costs designers and builders for many of the structures erected in Carrollton since its founding In the Selective Architectural Inventory the book's

and architectural innovation shaped the incomparable Garden District **Building Antebellum New Orleans** Tara Dudley, 2021-08-10 2024 Spiro Kostof Book Award Society of Architectural Historians 2022 PROSE Award in Architecture and Urban Planning 2022 Summerlee Book Prize in Nonfiction Center for History and Culture of Southeast Texas and the Upper Gulf Coast 2022 Best Book Prize Southeast Chapter of the Society of Architectural Historians 2022 On the Brinck Book Award University of New Mexico School of Architecture Planning A significant and deeply researched examination of the free nineteenth century Black developers who transformed the cultural and architectural legacy of New Orleans The Creole architecture of New Orleans is one of the city's most recognized features but studies of it largely have focused on architectural typology In *Building Antebellum New Orleans* Tara A Dudley examines the architectural activities and influence of gens de couleur libres free people of color in a city where the mixed race descendants of whites and other free Blacks could own property Between 1820 and 1850 New Orleans became an urban metropolis and industrialized shipping center with a growing population Amidst dramatic economic and cultural change in the mid antebellum period the gens de couleur libres thrived as property owners developers building artisans and patrons Dudley writes an intimate microhistory of two prominent families of Black developers the Dollioles and Souli's to explore how gens de couleur libres used ownership engagement and entrepreneurship to construct individual and group identity and stability With deep archival research Dudley re-creates in fine detail the material culture business and social history and politics of the built environment for free people of color and adds new revelatory information to the canon on New Orleans architecture Race and Education in New Orleans Walter Stern, 2018-05-04 Surveying the two centuries that preceded Jim Crow's demise *Race and Education in New Orleans* traces the course of the city's education system from the colonial period to the start of school desegregation in 1960 This timely historical analysis reveals that public schools in New Orleans both suffered from and maintained the racial stratification that characterized urban areas for much of the twentieth century Walter C Stern begins his account with the mid eighteenth century kidnapping and enslavement of Marie Justine Sirnir who eventually secured her freedom and played a major role in the development of free black education in the Crescent City As Sirnir's story and legacy illustrate schools such as the one she envisioned were central to the black antebellum understanding of race citizenship and urban development Black communities fought tirelessly to gain better access to education which gave rise to new strategies by white civilians and officials who worked to maintain and strengthen the racial status quo even as they conceded to demands from the black community for expanded educational opportunities The friction between black and white New Orleanians continued throughout the nineteenth century and well into the twentieth when conflicts over land and resources sharply intensified Stern argues that the post Reconstruction reorganization of the city into distinct black and white enclaves marked a new phase in the evolution of racial disparity segregated schools gave rise to segregated communities which in turn created structural inequality in housing that impeded desegregation's capacity to promote racial justice By taking a long

view of the interplay between education race and urban change Stern underscores the fluidity of race as a social construct and the extent to which the Jim Crow system evolved through a dynamic though often improvisational process A vital and accessible history Race and Education in New Orleans provides a comprehensive look at the ways the New Orleans school system shaped the city's racial and urban landscapes The Year Book of Tulane University School of Architecture and the H. Plater,2015-11-18 In 1833 Edward G W and Frances Parke Butler moved to their newly constructed plantation house Dunboyne on the banks of the Mississippi River near the village of Bayou Goula Their experiences at Dunboyne over the next forty years demonstrated the transformations that many land owning southerners faced in the nineteenth century from the evolution of agricultural practices and commerce to the destruction wrought by the Civil War and the transition from slave to free labor and finally to the social political and economic upheavals of Reconstruction In this comprehensive biography of the Butlers David D Plater explores the remarkable lives of a Louisiana family during one of the most tumultuous periods in American history Born in Tennessee to a celebrated veteran of the American Revolution Edward Butler pursued a military career under the mentorship of his guardian Andrew Jackson and during a posting in Washington D C met and married a grand niece of George Washington Frances Parke Lewis In 1831 he resigned his commission and relocated Frances and their young son to Iberville Parish where the couple began a sugar cane plantation As their land holdings grew they amassed more enslaved laborers and improved their social prominence in Louisiana's antebellum society A staunch opponent of abolition Butler voted in favor of Louisiana's withdrawal from the Union at the state's Secession Convention But his actions proved costly when the war cut off agricultural markets and all but destroyed the state's plantation economy leaving the Butlers in financial ruin In 1870 with their plantation and finances in disarray the Butlers sold Dunboyne and resettled in Pass Christian Mississippi where they resided in a rental cottage with the financial support of Edward J Gay a wealthy Iberville planter and their daughter in law's father After Frances died in 1875 Edward Butler moved in with his son's family in St Louis where he remained until his death in 1888 Based on voluminous primary source material The Butlers of Iberville Parish Louisiana offers an intimate picture of a wealthy nineteenth century family and the turmoil they faced as a system based on the enslavement of others unraveled **Designing Pan-America** Robert Alexander González,2023-09-30 Coinciding with the centennial of the Pan American Union now the Organization of American States González explores how nineteenth and twentieth century U S architects and their clients built a visionary Pan America to promote commerce and cultural exchange between United States and Latin America Late in the nineteenth century U S commercial and political interests began eyeing the countries of Latin America as plantations farms and mines to be accessed by new shipping lines and railroads As their desire to dominate commerce and trade in the Western Hemisphere grew these U S interests promoted the concept of Pan Americanism to link the United States and Latin America and called on U S

architects to help set the stage for Pan Americanism's development. Through international expositions, monuments, and institution building, U.S. architects translated the concept of a united Pan American sensibility into architectural or built form. In the process, they also constructed an artificial ideological identity: a fictional Pan America peopled with imaginary Pan American citizens, the hemispheric loyalists who would support these projects and who were the presumed benefactors of this presumed architecture of unification. Designing Pan America presents the first examination of the architectural expressions of Pan Americanism. Concentrating on U.S. architects and their clients, Robert Alexander Gonzalez demonstrates how they proposed designs reflecting U.S. presumptions and projections about the relationship between the United States and Latin America. This forgotten chapter of American architecture unfolds over the course of a number of international expositions ranging from the North Central and South American Exposition of 1885-1886 in New Orleans to Miami's unrealized Interama fair and San Antonio's HemisFair 68, and encompassing the Pan American Union headquarters building in Washington, D.C. and the creation of the Columbus Memorial Lighthouse in the Dominican Republic.

Louisiana Buildings, 1720-1940

The only New Deal program to continue into the 1990s, the Historic American Buildings Survey has, through the years, drawn attention to the historical and artistic significance of buildings that contemporary taste might otherwise have ignored. Louisiana Buildings, 1720-1940 makes easily available the fruit of HABS's important and enduring efforts to record Louisiana's architectural heritage. In the 1930s, the Louisiana HABS team concentrated on public edifices and grand plantation complexes threatened by destruction. Later records of HABS include still other habitations of the common man as well as industrial structures. The project has yielded not only graphic and written documentation of the buildings, many no longer standing, but also new insights into the history of the state's architecture. An invaluable part of Louisiana Buildings, 1720-1940 is the alphabetical listing of HABS structures in Louisiana, both by familiar name and by parish. The listing by parish gives the location, the date of construction, the architect, when known, and the current status of each building. It also presents drawings or photographs of many of the structures: over 300 pictures in all. There are, besides, nine chapters by leading architectural historians who cover all aspects of Louisiana architecture: its Creole beginnings in the south, the Appalachian folk style in the north, and developments on the plantation in the seventeenth century, urban setting, and in the modern era. Those chapters form an essential frame of reference for the data in the HABS listings and call attention to many other structures that are a part of the history of building in the Pelican State. Anyone interested in the state's architecture or history will find Louisiana Buildings indispensable.
