

changed his method of dealing with his patients to listening to their associations he discovered the workings of the primary process the representation in the mind of the endosomatic stimuli and the manner in which the primary and the secondary processes entwine to form both the normal and abnormal psychical products Another theory of psychoanalysis came out of those core observations and Freud was able to give psychoanalysis a central position in western culture as a whole and a significant place in the study and treatment of mental disorders Freud's unstated discoveries had all the elements of another full theory it was the theory that gave psychoanalysis its outstanding status However he did not articulate it as a distinct theory that could replace the catharsis theory.
