In Search of Greater Syria Christopher Solomon, 2021-09-23 The Syrian Social Nationalist Party SSNP is one of the most enigmatic and active political forces in the Middle East For observers in the West the SSNP is regarded as a far right organization subservient to the Baathist government of Syrian President Bashar al Assad which dictates its activities from Damascus However the SSNP's

complicated history and its ideology of Pan Syrianism has meant the party has been overlooked and forgotten by the daily output of news analysis studies and policy recommendations Very little academic scholarship has been dedicated to understanding its origins identity and influence Addressing the need for scholarship on the SSNP this book is a political history from the party's foundation in 1932 to today A comprehensive and objective study on the little known nationalist group the author uses interviews from current members to gain insights into its everyday activities goals social interstices and nuances Given the SSNP's history of violence their own persecution influence on other secular parties in the region and their impact in Syria and Lebanon's politics the book's analysis sheds light on the party's status in Lebanon and its potential role in a future post war Syria The SSNP is gaining popularity among regime supporters in Syria and will be one part of understanding the political developments on the ground This book is essential reading for those wanting to understand the SSNP its motives and prospects

Monroe, 2016-03-15 Fifteen years after the end of a protracted civil and regional war Beirut broke out in violence once again forcing residents to contend with many forms of insecurity amid an often violent political and economic landscape Providing a picture of what ordinary life is like for urban dwellers surviving sectarian violence *The Insecure City* captures the day to day experiences of citizens of Beirut moving through a war torn landscape While living in Beirut Kristin Monroe conducted interviews with a diverse group of residents of the city She found that when people spoke about getting around in Beirut they were also expressing larger

concerns about social political and economic life It was not only violence that threatened Beirut s ordinary residents but also class dynamics that made life even more precarious For instance the installation of checkpoints and the rerouting of traffic set up for the security of the elite forced the less fortunate to alter their lives in ways that made them more at risk Similarly the ability to pass through security blockades often had to do with an individual s visible markers of class such as clothing hairstyle and type of car Monroe examines how understandings and practices of spatial mobility in the city reflect social differences and how such experiences led residents to be bitterly critical of their government In *The Insecure City* Monroe takes urban anthropology in a new and meaningful direction discussing traffic in the Middle East to show that when people move through Beirut they are experiencing the intersection of citizen and state of the more and less privileged and in general the city s politically polarized geography

The Peace In Between Astri Suhrke,Mats Berdal,2013-03 This volume examines the causes and purposes of post conflict violence The end of a war is generally expected to be followed by an end to collective violence as the term post conflict that came into general usage in the 1990s signifies In reality however various forms of deadly violence continue and sometimes even increase after the big guns have been silenced and a peace agreement signed Explanations for this and other kinds of violence fall roughly into two broad categories those that stress the legacies of the war and those that focus on the conditions of the peace There are significant gaps in the literature most importantly arising from the common premise that there is one predominant type of post war situation This post war state is often endowed with certain generic features that predispose it towards violence such as a weak state criminal elements generated by the war time economy demobilized but not demilitarized or reintegrated ex combatants impunity and rapid liberalization The premise of this volume differs It argues that features which constrain or encourage violence stack up in ways to create distinct and different types of post war environments Critical factors that shape the post war environment in this respect lie in the war to peace transition itself above all the outcome of the war in terms of military and political power and its relationship to social hierarchies of power normative understandings of the post war order and the international context This book will of much interest to students of war and conflict studies peacebuilding and IR Security Studies in general
