Smoliar, Mark Stefik, 1994 One place where the scientific debate has been written for a broad audience is in the book review column of the international journal Artificial Intelligence which has evolved from simple reviews to a multidisciplinary forum where reviewers and authors debate the latest often competing theories of human and artificial intelligence **Vanishing Voices** Daniel Nettle, Suzanne Romaine, 2000-07-27 Few people know that nearly one hundred native languages once spoken in what is now California are near extinction or that most of Australia's 250 aboriginal languages have vanished In fact at least half of the world's languages may die out in the next century Daniel Nettle and Suzanne Romaine assert that this trend is far more than simply disturbing Making explicit the link between language survival and environmental issues they argue that the extinction of languages is part of the larger picture of near total collapse of the worldwide ecosystem Indeed the authors contend that the struggle to preserve precious environmental resources such as the rainforest cannot be separated from the struggle to maintain diverse cultures and that the causes of language death like that of ecological destruction lie at the intersection of ecology and politics In addition to defending the world's endangered languages the authors also pay homage to the last speakers of dying tongues such as Red Thundercloud a Native American in South Carolina Ned Mandrell with whom the Manx language passed away in 1974 and Arthur Bennett an Australian who was the last person to know more than a few words of Mbabaram In our languages lies the accumulated knowledge of humanity Indeed each language is a unique window on experience Vanishing Voices is a call to preserve this resource before it is too late **Moral Imagination** Mark Johnson, 1993 The Enlightenment idea that reason creates fixed moral rules that specify the right thing to do is mistaken according to Johnson because it misses the ways in which human conceptual systems are grounded in bodily experience and it ignores the expansive and constructive nature of our best moral thinking Since new findings in cognitive science explain reasoning in terms of prototypes frame semantics metaphor and basic level experience Johnson contends that we must revise our views of ethics and adopt an alternative conception of moral reflection one that is thoroughly imaginative **Seeing and Showing the Unseen** Adam Szumorek, 2023-10-31 As humans we think in images and cannot do otherwise Thus metaphor and imagery often viewed as complex literary devices are in fact the very building blocks of human thought and essential components for understanding the nature of God Exploring how the God of Scripture reveals himself through metaphor and imagery Dr Adam Szumorek utilizes Cognitive Linguistics to help students teachers

Levinson, 2000-08 Every discipline has its canon, the set of standard texts, approaches, examples, and stories by which it is recognized and which its members repeatedly invoke and employ Although the last twenty-five years have seen the influence of interdisciplinary approaches to legal studies expand, there has been little recent consideration of what is and what ought to be canonical in the study of law today Legal Canons brings together fifteen essays which seek to map out the legal canon and the way in which law is taught today In order to understand how the twin ideas of canons and canonicity operate in law, each essay focuses on a particular aspect, from contracts and constitutional law to questions of race and gender The ascendancy of law and economics, feminism, critical race theory, and gay legal studies, as well as the increasing influence of both rational actor methodology and postmodernism, are all scrutinized by the leading scholars in the field A timely and comprehensive volume Legal Canons articulates the need for, and means to, opening the debate on canonicity in legal studies

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
