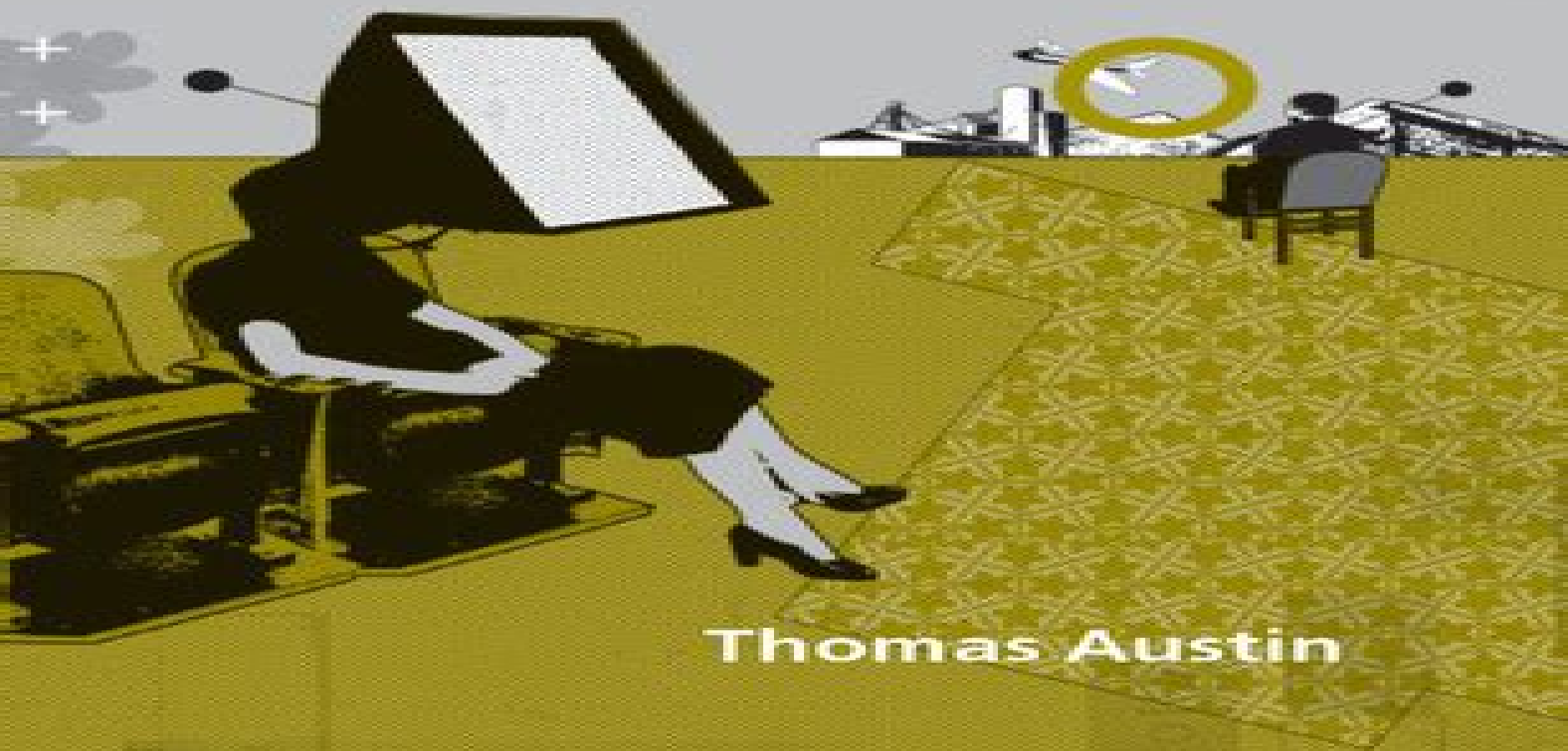

Watching the World Thomas Austin, 2013-07-19 Screen documentary has experienced a marked rise in visibility and popularity in recent years What are the reasons for the so called boom in documentaries at the cinema How has television documentary met the challenge of new formats And how do audiences engage with documentaries on screen Watching the world extends the reach of documentary studies by investigating recent instances of screen documentary and the uses made of them by audiences The book focuses on the interfaces between textual mechanisms promotional tactics and audiences viewing strategies Key topics of inquiry are film and televisual form truth claims and issues of trust the pleasures politics and the ethics of documentary Case studies include Capturing the Friedmans tre et Avoir Paradise Lost Touching the Void and wildlife documentaries on television This compelling and accessible book will be of interest to both students and fans of documentary

Heritage Film Audiences Claire Monk, 2011-06-30 The concept of heritage cinema is now firmly established as an influential as well as much debated and contested critical framework for the discussion of period or historical representation in film most prominently with reference to British heritage and post heritage film successes since the 1980s but also to comparable examples from Europe North America and beyond These successes have ranged from Merchant Ivory s A Room with a View Maurice Howards End and The Remains of the Day via Jane Austen adaptations such as Ang Lee s Sense and Sensibility to post heritage adaptations such as Sally Potter s Orlando Yet the very idea of the heritage film has rested on untested assumptions about its audiences This book breaks significant new ground in the scholarship on contemporary period films and makes a distinctive new contribution to the growing field of film audience studies by presenting the first empirically based study of the audiences for quality period films Monk engages directly with two highly contrasting sections of these audiences surveyed in the UK in the late 1990s to explore their identities their wider patterns of film taste and above all their attitudes and pleasures in relation to the period films they enjoy and on issues central to debates around the heritage film literary adaptation and cultural value with illuminating and unpredicted results

Justice on Demand Tanya Horeck, 2019-11-11 Explores the proliferation of true crime audiovisual texts across multiple media platforms Justice on Demand True Crime in the Digital Streaming Era offers a theoretical rumination on the question asked in countless blogs and opinion pieces of the last decade Why are we so obsessed with true crime Author Tanya Horeck takes this question further Why is true crime thought to be such a good vehicle for the new modes of viewer listener engagement favored by online streaming and consumption in the twenty first century Examining a range of audiovisual true crime texts from podcasts such as Serial and My Favorite Murders to long form crime documentaries such as The Jinx and Making a Murderer Horeck considers the extent to which the true crime genre has come to epitomize participatory media culture where the listener viewer acts as a desktop detective or internet sleuth While Facebook and Twitter have re invigorated the notion of the armchair detective Horeck questions the rhetoric of interactivity surrounding true crime formats and points to

the precarity of justice in the social media era In a cultural moment in which user generated videos of real life violence surface with an alarming frequency Justice on Demand addresses what is at stake in the cultural investment in true crime as packaged mainstream entertainment Paying close attention to the gendered and racialized dimensions of true crime media Horeck examines objects that are not commonly considered true crime including the subgenre of closed circuit television CCTV elevator assault videos and the popularity of trailers for true crime documentaries on YouTube By analyzing a range of intriguing case studies Horeck explores how the audience is affectively imagined addressed and commodified by contemporary true crime in an on demand mediascape As a fresh investigation of how contemporary variations of true crime raise significant ethical questions regarding what it means to watch listen and witness in a digital era of accessibility immediacy and instantaneity Justice on Demand will be of interest to film media and digital studies scholars
