
TOXICOLOGY EXAM 1 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Thrombocytopenia - Answers :a condition where there are very low levels of thrombocytes (platelets) in the blood. Anything less than 150,000 platelets. Less than 20,000 can cause serious bleeding.

Agranulocytosis - Answers :It is a severe lack of one major class of infection-fighting white blood cells most often neutrophils. The bone marrow is not able to produce enough.

Pancytopenia - Answers :a person's body has too few red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets. Basically the person has three blood diseases (anemia, thrombocytopenia, and leukopenia)

Polycythemia - Answers :a disease where the bone marrow produces too many red blood cells. There are two types primary and secondary. Primary is there are issues in the process of red blood cell production. Secondary is usually a response to factors or conditions that promote red blood cell production

Toxin - Answers :any of various unstable poisonous compounds produced by some microorganisms and causing certain diseases. Any of various similar poisons, related to proteins, secreted by plants and animals, as snake venom.

Mechanistic Toxicologist - Answers :concerned with elucidating the mechanisms by which chemicals exert their toxic effects on living systems.

Cooperativity - Answers :a phenomenon in which the shape of one subunit of an enzyme consisting of several subunits is altered by the substrate (the substance upon which an enzyme acts to form a product) or some other molecule so as to change the shape of a neighbouring subunit. The result is that the binding of a second substrate molecule to the second subunit of the enzyme differs in strength or velocity from that of the first, the third from the second, and so on. If the change in shape of the first subunit makes easier the binding of substrate to the second subunit, the effect is called positive cooperativity. In negative cooperativity, the binding of a molecule to the first subunit makes more difficult the binding of substrate to the second.

Show how you would predict its absorption from the stomach (pH 2) and intestine (pH 6) (Note: you may leave your answers in ratio form, but be sure to state whether absorption will or will not be favored). - Answers : $pK_a - pH = \log(\text{ionized}/\text{nonionized})$
