Naval Operations Office,1972 **A Sailor's History of the U.S. Navy** Thomas J Cutler,2005-01-15 Today's sailors have too little appreciation of their heritage To counter this problem Thomas J Cutler has compiled a history of our naval heritage in the form of A Sailor's History of the U S Navy The work is unique in two important ways First it is written thematically rather than chronologically This allows recent history to be blended with more distant but important events in ways that will reinforce the timelessness as well as the timeliness of the U S Navy thereby having a greater appeal to today's sailor There are a number of themes being used the most obvious are manifested in chapters with the themes of honor courage and commitment but others serve as useful vehicles as well for example there is a chapter called What's in a Name that briefly discusses how ships have been named and then uses the many ships that have carried the name Enterprise as the theme for presenting significant portions of the Navy's history The other unique characteristic of this history is that it focuses wherever possible on the roles of ALL sailors rather than just the officers That is not to say that Jones and Decatur are not there but that the emphasis is along the lines of the crew of the Bon Homme Richard fought on into the night rather than Jones fought Also there are plenty of individual sailor heroes who can stand alongside the Perrys and the Farraguts Boatswain's Mate First Class Williams who won the Medal of Honor in Vietnam Dorie Miller of Pearl Harbor fame Gunner's Mate Third Class Paul Henry Carr at the battle off Samar etc Some emphasis upon what it was like to be a sailor working and living conditions at different times is included as well

The Midshipman Culture and Educational Reform Todd A. Forney, 2004 The *Midshipman Culture and Educational Reform* examines the effect of educational and professional reforms on the culture of Annapolis from 1945-76 The Naval Academy has juggled the competing priorities of training and education throughout its history Proper balance was a perennial problem since the academy was limited to a four year timetable to graduation Bancroft Hall was the focal point for professional indoctrination and the heart and soul of the academy culture Its traditions and activities often competed with academics for the midshipmen's time and attention technology and operational requirements forced the school to reevaluate the emphasis paid to academics Outside groups such as the Folsom Board and Admiral Hyman Rickover also acted as a catalyst for reform The culmination of these efforts was the academic revolution of the 1960s which transformed Annapolis into an elite engineering college Midshipmen and their officers occasionally resisted changes that undercut their most cherished traditions including plebe indoctrination Ironically most core values of the academy culture remained similar to what they had always been including the emphasis on career service and loyalty to one's shipmates Fomey's book uses all original sources including a thorough survey of graduates from these years

Coulter,2017-03-24 Since the founding of the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1802 more than eight hundred military schools have existed in this country The vast majority have closed their doors been absorbed into other educational institutions or otherwise faded away but others soldier on adapting to changing times and changing educational needs While many individual institutions have had their histories written or their stories told to date no single book has attempted to explore the full scope of the military school in American history Cadets on Campus is the first book to cover the origin history and culture of the nation s military schools secondary and collegiate and this breadth of coverage will appeal to historians and alumni alike Author John Alfred Coulter identifies several key figures who were pivotal to the formation of military education including Sylvanus Thayer the father of West Point and Alden Partridge the founder of the school later known as Norwich University the first private military school in the country He also reveals that military schools were present across the nation despite the conventional wisdom that most military schools and indeed the culture that surrounds them were limited to the South Coulter addresses the shuttering of military schools in the era after the Vietnam War and then notes a curious resurgence of interest in military education since the turn of the century

Commander Will Cushing Jamie Malanowski,2014-10-13 Superbly entertaining S C Gwynne best selling author of Empire of the Summer Moon October 1864 The confederate ironclad CSS Albemarle had sunk two federal warships and damaged seven others taking control of the Roanoke River and threatening the Union blockade Twenty one year old navy lieutenant William Barker Cushing hatched a daring plan to attack the fearsome warship with a few dozen men in two small wooden boats What followed the close range torpedoing of the Albemarle and Cushing s harrowing two day escape downriver from vengeful Rebel posses is one of the most dramatic individual exploits in American military history Theodore Roosevelt said that Cushing comes next to Farragut on the hero roll of American naval history but most have never heard of him today Tossed out of the Naval Academy for buffoonery Cushing proved himself a prodigy in behind the lines warfare Given command of a small union ship he performed daring near suicidal raids cutting out confederate ships and thwarting blockade runners With higher commands and larger ships Cushing s exploits grow bolder culminating in the sinking of the Albemarle

A thrilling narrative biography steeped in the tactics weaponry and battle techniques of the Union Navy Commander Will Cushing brings to life a compelling yet flawed figure Along with his three brothers including one who fell at Gettysburg Cushing served with bravery and heroism But he was irascible and complicated a loveable rogue prideful and impulsive who nonetheless possessed a genius for combat In telling Cushing s story Malanowski paints a vivid memorable portrait of the army officials engineers and politicians scrambling to win the war But he also goes deeper into the psychology of the daredevil soldier and what this heroic and tragic figure who died before his time can tell us about the ways we remember the glories of war

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
