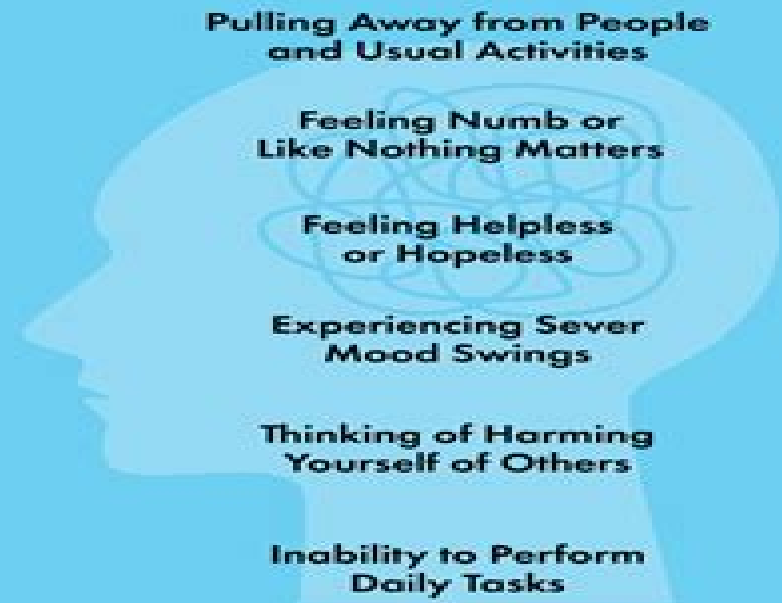

What Is Mental Illness? Richard J.
