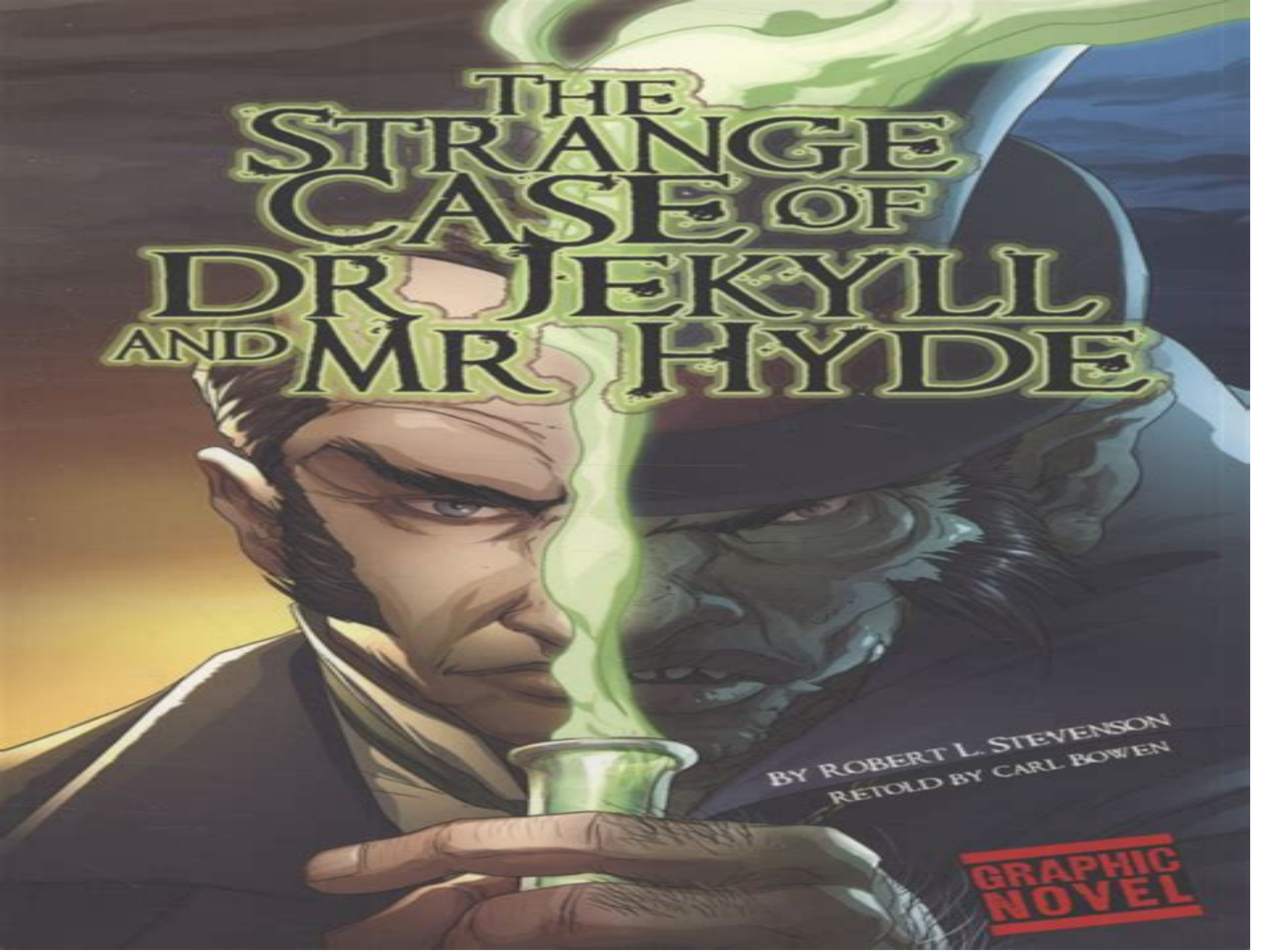

a kind and responsible man but he is worried It seems Dr Jekyll is protecting Mr Hyde but why As we follow Mr Utterson and through the clever use of letters written by Jekyll and Hyde we discover the terrible secret that connects them This is a very well written book with descriptive and powerful language The characters and their feelings are described beautifully for example Mr Utterson spent his words as rarely as gold and Hyde who stares at people with a sneering coolness like the devil himself making people feel uncomfortable just by looking at him There are two main ideas in the story Firstly the battle of good versus evil We see this in the story of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde and how he struggles to keep balance between both sides of himself Secondly it is about taking science too far and if we can control scientific research
